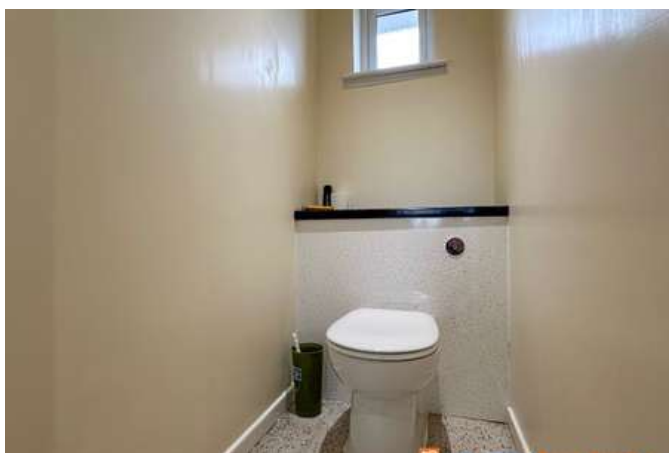




MARKETED WITH NO CHAIN. Situated in a relatively central residential location, providing ease of access into Newark Town Centre, lies this deceptively spacious detached bungalow, benefiting from a generous plot offering huge scope to extend if desired.

The property's accommodation comprises: entrance porch, inviting hallway with useful storage and parquet flooring, which extends through to the bedrooms and dual aspect bay fronted lounge, modern kitchen with pantry cupboard and a range of Neff appliances to include a hide-and-slide electric oven, electric hob, dishwasher and fridge. There are also two double bedrooms, three piece bathroom suite and a separate WC.

Outside, the property enjoys a lawned frontage and driveway to the side which leads down to the garage and workshop/lean to. The rear garden is predominantly laid to lawn and represents a blank canvas allowing a buyer to make this space their own. Other features include gas central heating and UPVC double glazing.

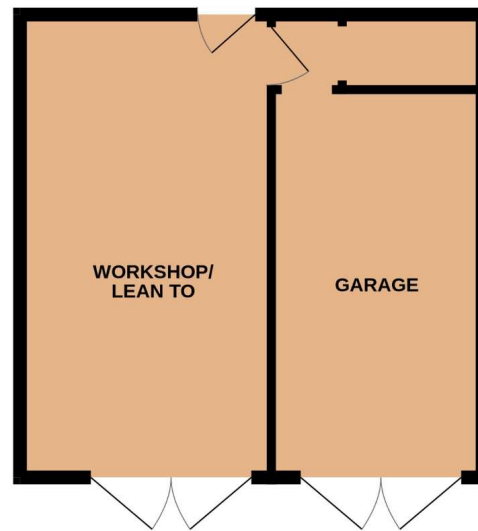

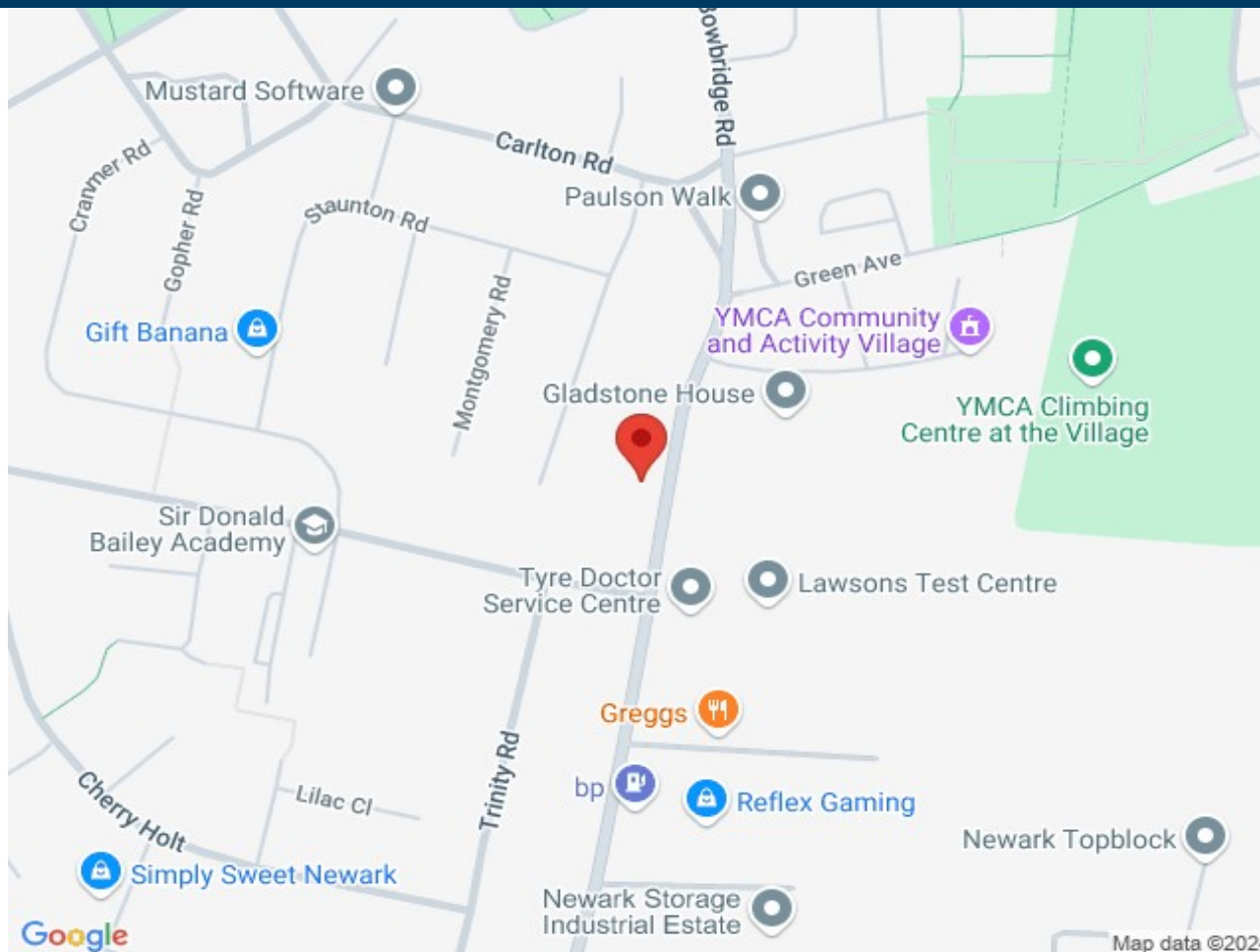
