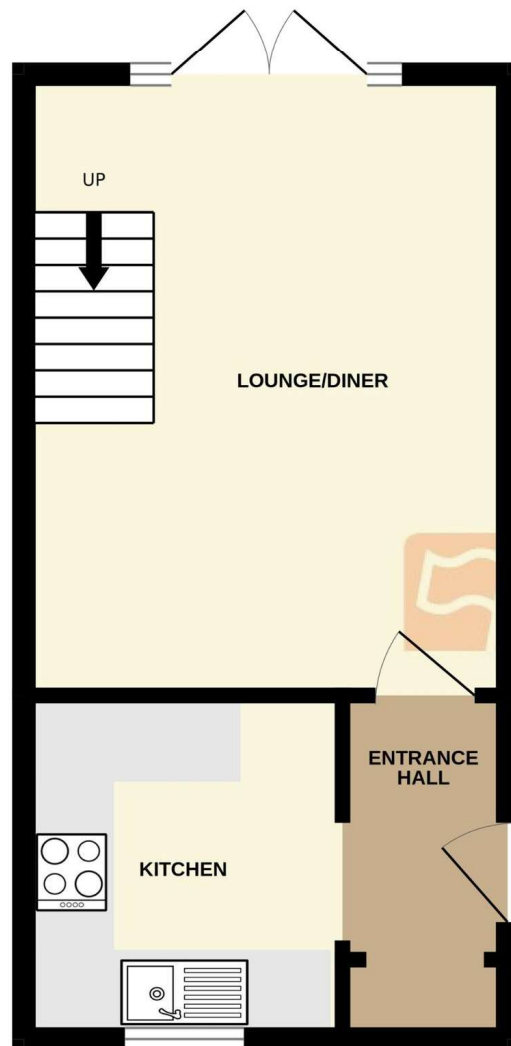

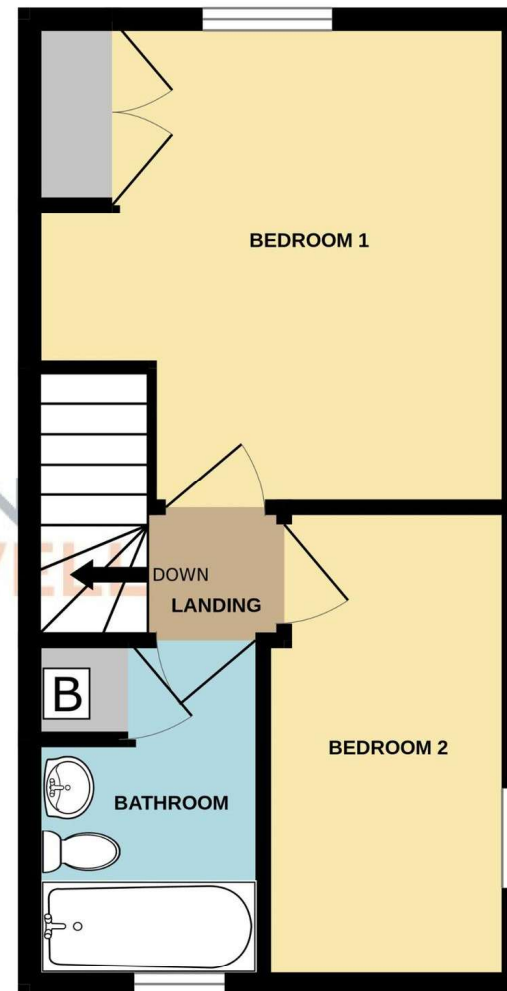

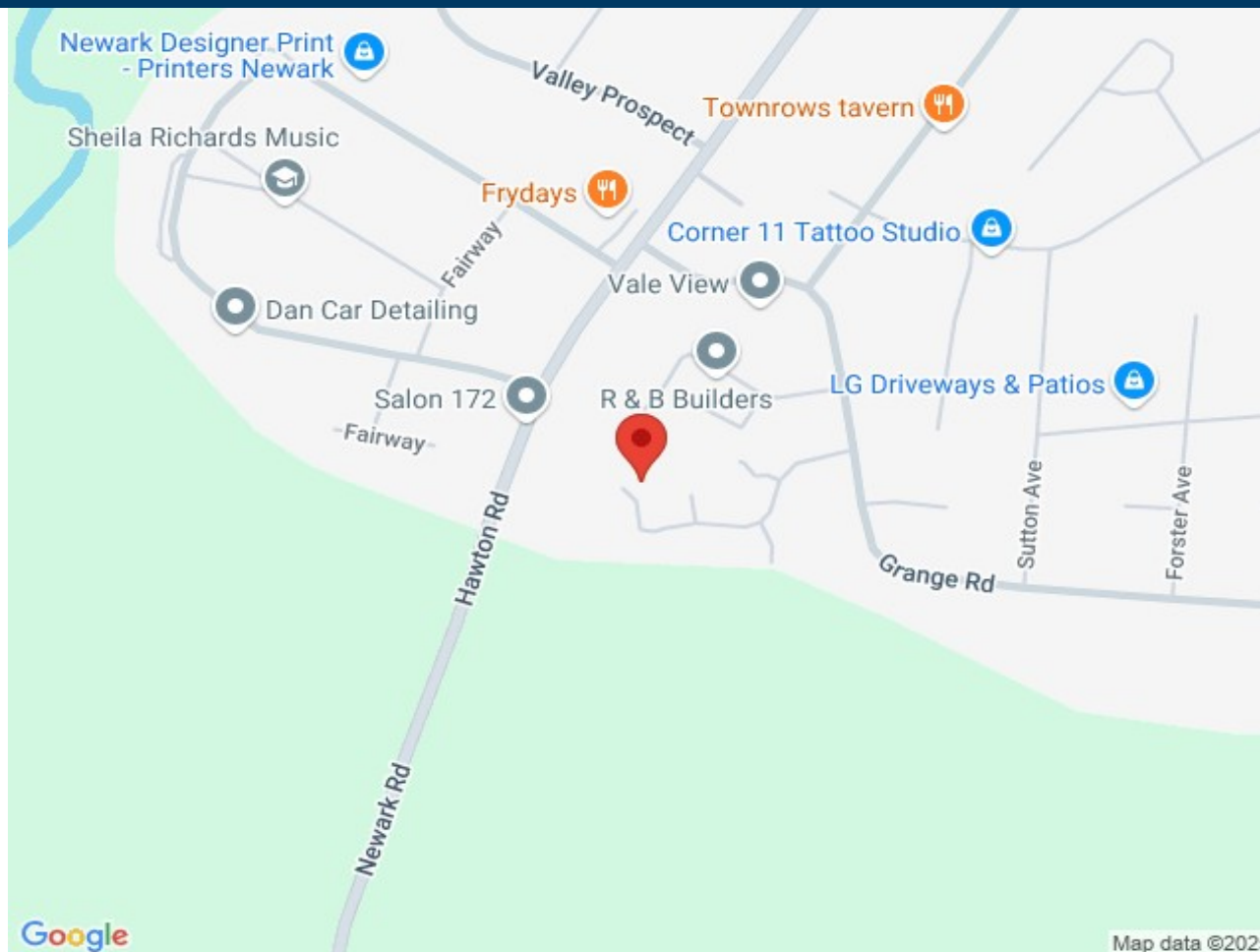


GROUND FLOOR
