Situated at the top of this most popular of coastal villages, Lancecliffe House is a distinctive post war house which occupies a large plot that is nicely set back off Mount Pleasant South. It affords a delightful south-easterly aspect with views over the bay from the upper windows with the accommodation offering spacious living with 2 reception rooms, 3 double bedrooms and a shower room as well as a house bathroom. Although in need of some upgrading modernisation to bring it up to modern day standards, the house does, nevertheless, have the benefit of gas central heating and double glazing throughout.

It is, however, the beautiful space there garden offers that makes the house stand out. The southerly aspect allows for virtual all day sun, allowing plants and the lawn to flourish, whilst the space allows for further extension of the house if required, or the creation of further parking if so desired.

All in all, a truly wonderful house, that should be viewed to be fully appreciated.

From the front of the property an open porch gives access to the uPVC entrance door which opens into a large attractive entrance hallway off which there is a W.C and built in cloaks cupboard. Stairs (with under-stairs cupboard) rise up to a 1st floor whilst panel doors opening into ...



Lounge - A light and spacious room with large bay window, which has double doors out to the garden, focal fireplace and further small windows to the side and rear.



Breakfast/Sitting Room – A nicely proportioned room with focal gas fireplace in a wood surround. There is large window to the front overlooking the garden, built-in storage cupboard and door to the kitchen.



Kitchen – Having fitted pine base units with laminated working surfaces, tiled splash-backs and matching wall cupboards over. There is an inset stainless steel sink unit and space for a gas cooker. A door from here leads into the...

Utility – Joining the house to the garage, this irregular shaped room has doors to both front and rear, with plumbing for an automatic washing machine and space for drier and fridge freezer. The gas central heating boiler is situated here.

1st Floor


Steps rise to the first floor where there light open landing area, with fitted cupboard and large walk-in airing cupboard. Doors open to the bedrooms, bathroom and separate shower room.

Shower room – With walk-in cubicle, heated towel rail and w.c

Double Bedroom – A light spacious room with windows to the side and front, affording lovely views over the village to the bay and Ravenscar beyond.



Bedroom – A small double room/large single with window to the front, again affording views over the bay to Ravenscar.





Double Bedroom – Again a light and airy room with windows to the side and front, again with sea views. There is a small recessed cupboard to the rear of the room.



Bathroom – With window to the front, coloured suite comprising bath with mixer tap/shower and pedestal hand basin. There is tiling to the walls and built-in cupboard

Outside

Lancecliffe House is set back from Mount Pleasant South, set behind a low brick wall with driveway down the house and garage. The front garden is largely gravelled with some mature trees and shrubs

Attached Garage – with up and over door, electric supplied and courtesy door to the rear.



The house sits in large gardens which are largely set to lawn with mature shrubs and trees, including fruit trees.

Within the grounds there is a summer house and greenhouse, both of which are included in the sale. To the bottom of the garden is a large flatter area which has previously been used as a productive vegetable patch but in recent years has been allowed to revert to grass.


