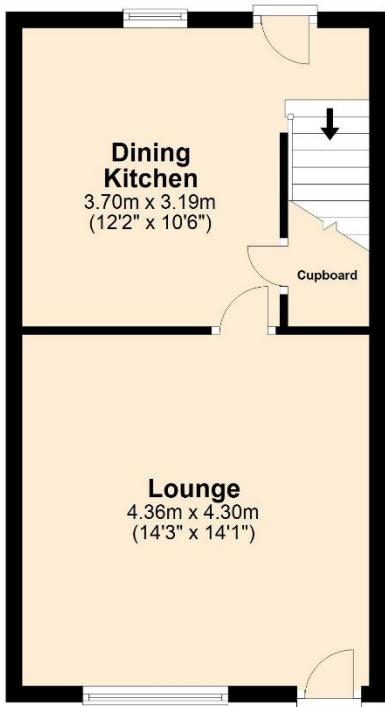

The property benefits from having gas central heating and upvc double glazing throughout.

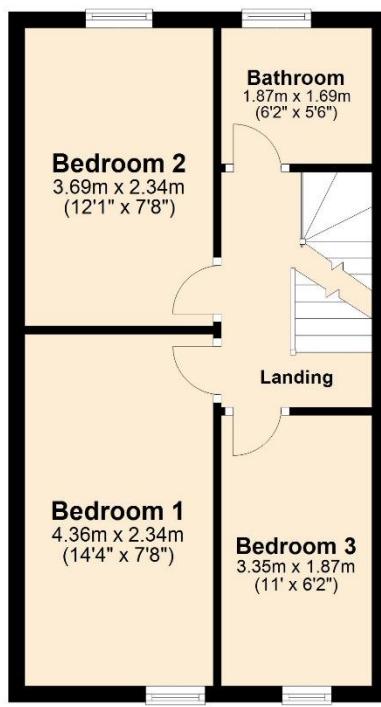


There is a private and low-maintenance yard located at the rear.
