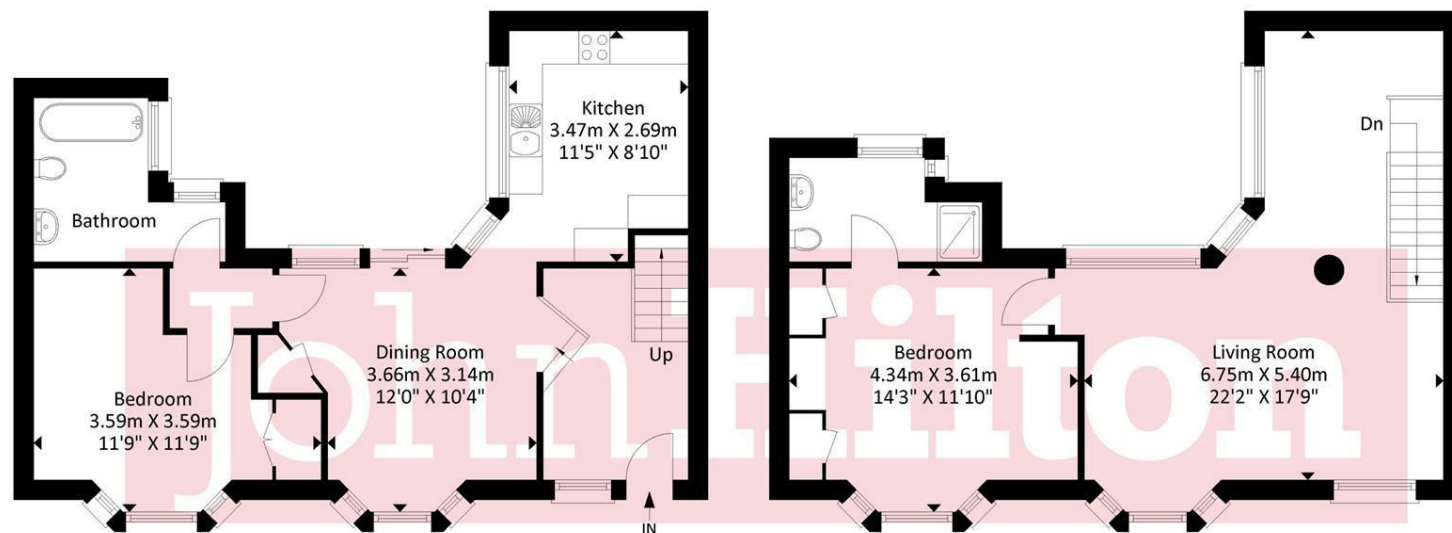


Toronto Terrace, Brighton

Entrance Hall

Floor-to-ceiling frosted glass window, open tread staircase to first floor, 'Fired Earth' tiled floor.

Dining Area

3.66m x 3.14m (12'0" x 10'3")

Bay window to front, wall-mounted display unit with base units below (one housing tumble dryer) and distressed cement grey countertop, built-in corner cupboard, sliding patio doors to garden. 'Fired Earth' tiled floor extends through to:

Kitchen

3.47m x 2.69m (11'4" x 8'9")

Modern fitted kitchen with handleless units at eye and base level, distressed cement grey worktops with mosaic-tiled splashbacks and under-counter downlights. Inset one-and-a-half bowl sink with mixer tap, built-in oven with fitted microwave over, gas hob with extractor hood over, integrated dishwasher and washing machine, kick boards incorporating LED lighting, 'Fired Earth' tiled floor and window to rear.

Inner Hallway

'Fired Earth' tiled floor.

Bedroom

3.59m x 3.59m (11'9" x 11'9")

Bay window, fitted carpet, recessed built-in cupboards.

Bathroom

Panel-enclosed bath with mixer tap and marble-effect aquaboard surround, vanity unit comprising wash basin with mixer tap, marble-effect splashbacks, storage cupboard below and WC with concealed cistern. Fitted mirror with sensor touch LED lighting, display shelving with built-in cabinet lighting, heated towel rail, wall-mounted 'Vaillant' boiler and 'Fired Earth' tiled floor. Two windows to rear.

Dual-Aspect Living Area

4.34m x 3.61m (14'2" x 11'10")

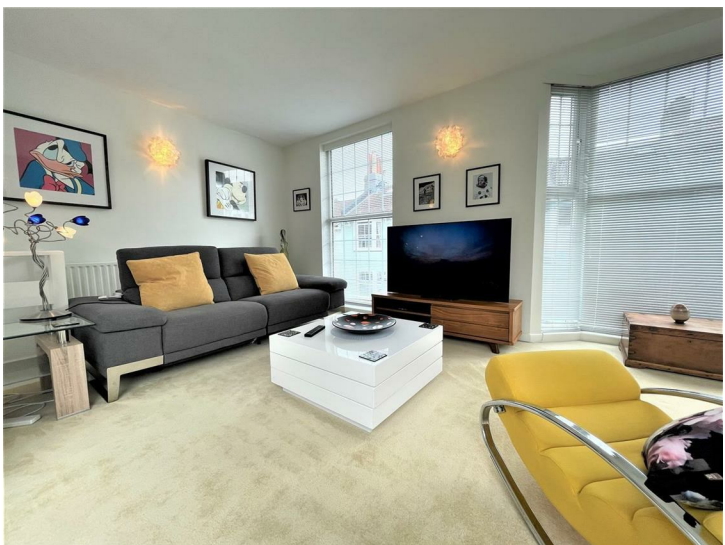
Bay window, fitted carpet, full-width bespoke built-in wardrobes with sliding doors, fitted with shelving, hanging rails and chest of drawers, entrance to loft.

En-Suite Shower Room

Recessed shower enclosure with marble-effect aquaboard surround, raised shower head and massage jets. Vanity unit comprising wash basin with mixer tap, marble-effect splashbacks, storage cupboard below and WC with concealed cistern, with wall-mounted storage cupboards above and fitted mirror with sensor touch LED lighting. Vertical radiator, 'Fired Earth' tiled floor and windows to rear.

West-Facing Patio Garden

Secluded sun trap with 'Fired Earth' tiled floor and feature mosaic-tiled boundary wall.
