Tucked away in the ever-popular village of Egton, just a short drive from Whitby, this charming stone-built cottage blends character and comfort with a generous layout and beautiful outdoor space.

The ground floor welcomes you with a cosy lounge, complete with open fire and feature fireplace, and a spacious kitchen/diner with a traditional Rayburn, Belfast sink and timber cabinetry—bringing a warm, country feel to the space.

Upstairs, there are two double bedrooms, both with en-suite shower rooms, while the top floor offers a third double, a single room, and a stylish house bathroom. A split-level landing adds a lovely sense of space and flow throughout.

Outside, the front garden is soon to be reconfigured to provide off-street parking for two to three vehicles. To the rear, the enclosed garden is a true highlight—private, easy to maintain and ideal for relaxing, with gravelled areas, mature hedging, and space for outdoor dining or play.

With period features such as exposed beams and cast-iron fireplace, oil central heating via the Rayburn, and an enviable location surrounded by North York Moors scenery, Wheatsheaf Cottage is perfect as a full-time home, holiday let, or country escape.
