


This beautifully presented flat found with a once GeorgianTownhouse, retains lots of character whilst offering comfortable, stylish accommodation in a town centre location.

Located on the second floor of this striking period building, upon entering the property you can see the restoration the current vendors have put in to this property.

Retaining many of the stunning original features that really add to the elegant feel of this apartment - such as picture rails, coving and panelling, the open plan lounge is drenched in natural light from the sash windows that overlook Bagdale. The original fireplace is still in situ and ties in beautifully with the stylish decor, there is ample space for dining, and the streamlined modern kitchen with NEFF electric oven and hob is small but perfectly formed with everything needed, including a dishwasher.


The house bathroom, again fully tiled, comprises shower, washbasin & W.C.

There are three parking spaces serving the block of four and a separate utility room off the hallway that belongs exclusively to Flat 3, a very useful space for doing laundry and storage.


Pets are NOT permitted as part of the lease restrictions but holiday letting and long term letting are allowed.

This town centre Flat is really beautifully done and offers its new owners a smart new property with the option to utilise a permanent home or investment.





