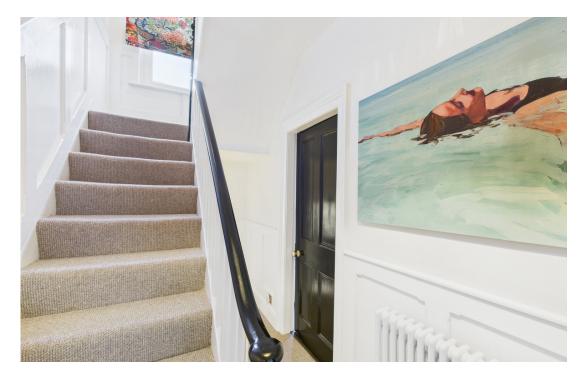












This breathtaking period home has been meticulously restored to the highest specification, celebrating its original features while introducing luxurious contemporary touches. Spanning 2,000 sq ft across four floors, it's a masterclass in design, comfort and coastal sophistication.

Created by House of Hildyard Interior Design, with lighting by Graham & Green, Pooky and OKA, the interiors balance coastal cool with timeless elegance. Every detail exudes quality — from bespoke fixtures and fittings to superior furnishings, kitchen worktops and bathroom furniture.

The first floor opens to a striking open-plan kitchen/dining area with quartz-topped island, range cooker and generous entertaining space. A bay window floods the room with light and frames the spectacular views. A cloakroom and shower room — ideal after beach days — complete this level, with access to a rear yard perfect for outdoor dining.

On the lower ground floor, a cosy snug offers a relaxed hideaway, alongside a fully fitted laundry room and access to the terraced garden.

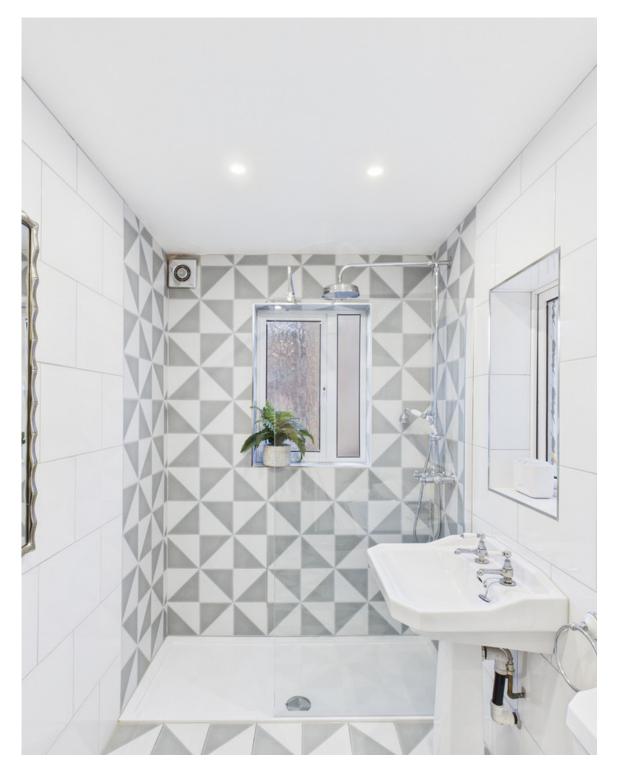

Mandalay House is truly one of a kind — with no compromise on space, functionality, flexibility and integrity. Any owner would be very proud to call it their own.



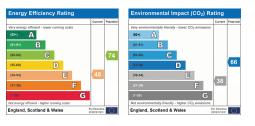
