
Introduction

A Premium Coastal Location



When you arrive in Broadstairs, it's no surprise that a certain Charles Dickens was enchanted by this old English town, the bearded one visited regularly between 1837 & 1859, he described it as "Our English Watering Place" and in his honour now stands a hugely popular museum and public house, 'The Charles Dickens'.

Residents at Lanthorne Place will be sure to get their 150 minutes of exercise per week, with the plethora of countryside and sporting facilities on the doorstep. For keen cyclists, the Viking Coastal Trail runs a 32- mile loop around the Isle of Thanet, from Broadstairs through to Ramsgate and Margate. Just a five-minute drive from home, North Foreland Golf Club is one of the most popular coastal golf clubs in the UK, with two popular courses overlooking the stunning white cliffs of the Kent coastline.



For everyday amenities there are supermarkets, a veterinary surgery, pharmacy, doctors' surgery and a butchers. The high street is also home to a selection of gift shops and boutiques, whilst the local restaurant scene is incredibly popular throughout Broadstairs and neighbouring Ramsgate.

There are also a number of tranquil walking routes along the beautiful coastline, including the Broadstairs to Ramsgate walk which leads to Ramsgate's Royal Harbour Marina where you can stop for fish and chips.

A perfect choice for families, Lanthorne Place is ideally located close to a number of first-class education options. Eight schools rated 'Outstanding' by Ofsted are within three miles of the development, including St Mildred's Primary Infant School, Upton Junior School and Dane Court Grammar School.

Well Connected

Lanthorne Place is perfectly situated for commuters looking to live further afield.

Just a 20-minute walk from home, Broadstairs Station offers direct services into London St Pancras in 1 hour 22 minutes, and London Victoria in just under 2 hours. For shopping, Westwood Cross shopping centre is only a short 10 minute drive away.

By road, the A28 can be joined in Margate and leads to the cathedral city of Canterbury, the M20, M2 and wider motorway network.

For international travel, Dover ferry port can be reached in 40 minutes from Lanthorne Place, offering direct services to French terminals Calais and Dunkirk.


