LOCATION

Barnsley has an urban population of approximately 230,000 people and is situated in South Yorkshire approximately 16 miles north of Sheffield and 23 miles south of Leeds.

The subject property is situated on Church Street opposite Barnsley College and close to the town centre amenities. Nearby occupiers include Heseltine Bray and Welsh Solicitors, The Cooper Art Gallery and Ridley and Hall Solicitors.

DESCRIPTION
