Location

Regents Court is located On Far Moor Lane, some 2 miles east of Redditch Town Centre, with access to the Coventry Highway, providing a dual carriageway link to the M42 about 3 miles to the North. Birmingham International Airport and the National Exhibition Centre are approximately 20 minutes drive away.

Description

Regents Court is a development of nine individual traditionally constructed Office buildings, grouped around a central, landscaped Courtyard.

Unit 6 is of cavity brick construction with a pitched slate roof. Internal finishes include suspended fissure-tiled ceilings and fluorescent inset strip lighting. Heating is provided by way of metal radiators connected to a gas-fired boiler.

The Ground Floor is available from April 2023, being open-plan with Meeting Room and Kitchenette. WC facilities are available.

The Ground Floor extends to some 1150 sq ft NIA.
