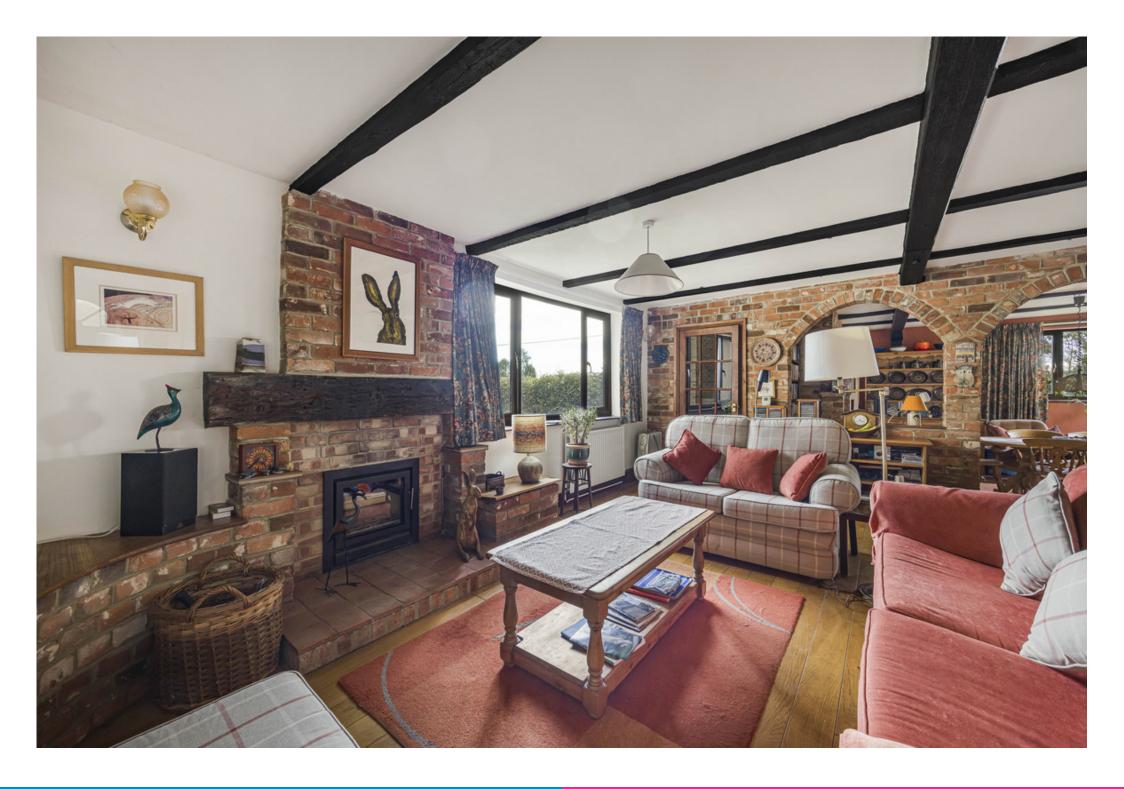

A charming four-bedroom detached Victorian barn conversion, enjoying countryside views and nestled in a highly sought-after village location, just a short distance from local shops and amenities.

The ground floor features a welcoming entrance hallway leading into a stunning sitting room, complete with wooden flooring, exposed brickwork, original beams, and access to a cloakroom via a connecting utility room.

Delightful archways add to the period charm and open into a formal dining area, perfect for entertaining. The spacious kitchen is well-equipped with an array of wall and base units, a built-in range cooker with extractor hood above, and flows seamlessly into a superb conservatory that enjoys views over the picturesque rear garden.

Upstairs, a bright and airy landing leads to four generously proportioned bedrooms. The principal bedroom benefits from a stylish en-suite shower room, while the remaining rooms are served by a contemporary family bathroom featuring both a bath and a separate shower.

The main entrance is located to the side of the property, accessed via a gated pathway. The beautifully landscaped rear garden is a tranquil haven, with a mix of patio and gravelled areas, a charming garden pond, and mature shrubs lining a meandering path that leads to a garden shed.

To the rear, there is a Right of Access over adjoining land, leading to a double carport offering convenient and secure parking. Further parking can also be found to the front of the property.

The Location

West Hendred is situated between Wantage and Harwell close to the Ridgeway for excellent walking/cycling activities and The Extraordinary Hare public house. In nearby East Hendred there are two pubs village shop pre school and two primary schools. The A34 is easily accessible with the M40 to the north and the M4 to the south Didcot c.5 miles offers a fast service to London Paddington c.40 minutes. The nearby town of Wantage offers schooling for all ages a range of shopping and leisure facilities as well as a twice weekly market.

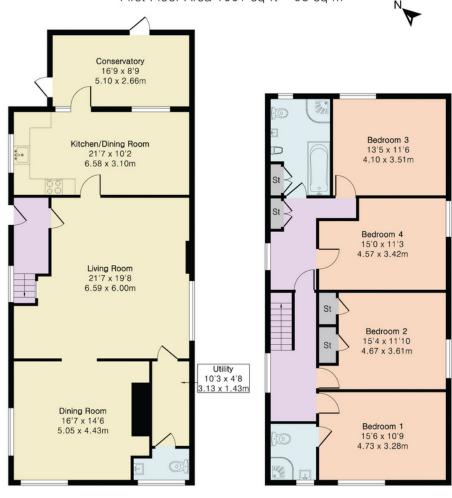
