



Upon entering, the scene is set by the fine flagstone floors of the entrance hall. The sitting room impresses with its exceptional ceiling heights, abundant natural light, and a tranquil ambiance. A central period fireplace, complete with a wood-burning stove, creates the perfect setting for cosy winter evenings. Adding to its allure, the room features a minstrel's gallery above.

The modern, well-appointed kitchen is ideally suited for both cooking and entertaining, complemented by a utility room and a separate cloakroom.

Upstairs, the first floor hosts a bedroom with a contemporary en suite bathroom, currently serving as a sitting room, with access to the minstrel's gallery overlooking the grand sitting area below.

The top floor offers three well-appointed bedrooms and a family bathroom.

Outside, the landscaped garden to the rear exudes the charm of a quintessential country cottage garden. A sun terrace provides a serene spot to relax and enjoy views of the mature shrub borders, sweeping lawn, brick-paved side terrace, and a convenient garden store. Interestingly, the original Crostwight Hall belonged to the first Prime Minister of Great Britain, Robert Walpole who acquired the property in 1720.







HISTORIC CHARM, SCENIC TRAILS, AND PEACEFUL COUNTRYSIDE

The small rural village of Crostwight is located approximately 13.5 miles southeast of Cromer. Known for its peaceful environment, traditional flintstone cottages, and beautiful landscapes types of the Norfolk countryside.

Crostwight is well-connected by road, with the A149 offering easy access to North Walsham and the North Nofolk coastline.

Steeped in history, Crostwight boasts a rich heritage. The village church, All Saints, is a notable feature thought to date back to the 14th century and restored in 19ll. The surrounding countryside is dotted with charming period properties, adding to the village's timeless appeal.

The village is surrounded by lush green fields and woodlands perfect for walking, cycling and bird watching. Nearby Bacton Woods offers extensive trails and picnic spots, making it a popular destination for family outings and outdoor adventures.
