Stepping through the entrance, a welcoming hallway runs through the heart of the home, giving way to beautifully arranged reception rooms. The sitting room is a magnificent space, bathed in natural light from its elegant bay window, with chevron-patterned parquet flooring adding a touch of refinement. A log burner nestles within the fireplace, creating a warm and inviting ambience. Flowing seamlessly, the dining room continues the graceful aesthetic with matching parquet flooring and a striking fireplace, leading into the well-appointed kitchen.

On the opposite side of the hallway, two further reception rooms offer excellent flexibility. Upstairs, the Georgian character continues with three beautifully proportioned double bedrooms, all brimming with charm. The family bathroom is finished to an excellent standard, featuring a large walk-in shower and tasteful modern fittings that complement the home's period aesthetic.

Externally, the home benefits from off-road parking and a delightful garden, offering a peaceful retreat in this highly popular village setting.
