SOWERBYS

This contemporary one-bedroom apartment is situated close to the city centre, within the prestigious Charles Church development, on the site of the former Norfolk and Norwich Hospital. A hospital had existed here since 1771, but the site was redeveloped and completed in 2009. Upon arrival at the apartment, prospective tenants are immediately welcomed into the entrance hall, which leads to the well-appointed accommodation.

Without a doubt, the hub of this spectacular city centre residence is the open-plan living area, which allows for entertainment and reception throughout all times of the day. The contemporary fitted kitchen, home to an abundance of both cupboard and worktop units, is perfect for those looking to display their culinary skills. The kitchen has an integral electric hob, oven, and a fridge freezer. The cosy open-plan sitting area provides versatile dimensions for all traditional furnishings.

The principal bedroom within the apartment is a spacious double room, benefitting from mirrored fitted wardrobes. Neighbouring the bedroom is the bathroom, which comprises a shower over bath, wash basin, WC, and a heated towel rail. Completing the accommodation is a useful airing cupboard offered with a washing machine.

The Pavilion is set within beautifully maintained communal grounds, and this particular fourth-floor apartment is accessed via a communal hall with security doors. There is a lift serving all floors and an allocated parking space.
