The Property was built circa 1800's and has been extended and offers versatile accommodation which is suited to family occupation. The gardens are extensive and in total the property stands in 3.66 acres. The property has the additional feature of a detached smaller cottage which is ideal and ripe for development. The former piggeries provide storage space, space over the garage and another outbuilding behind the property give potential for further development. The property has been improved by way of double glazing, part solid fuel for hot water and heating and night storage heating.
