The ground-floor accommodation features a spacious, bright entrance hall with a staircase leading to the first floor. The layout includes a cloakroom, a study, a gym with a sauna, a formal dining room, and a lounge with a wood burner and doors opening to enjoy garden views. Additionally, there is a utility room, a well-equipped kitchen, and a breakfast room that connects to the former double garage, which has been transformed into an annexe complete with a lounge, kitchen area, and an extra staircase leading to a bedroom with en-suite facilities.

Upstairs, you'll find three guest bedrooms, two of which feature en-suite bathrooms, along with a family bathroom. The master suite, located at the rear, includes a dressing area, an en-suite, and a stunning enclosed balcony that offers elevated views over the gardens and the surrounding countryside.




