The separate kitchen (14'6" x 8'2") offers ample worktop space and storage, overlooking the rear aspect and suited to everyday family life.

The second floor hosts three well-sized bedrooms, including a generous main bedroom (12'5" x 8'2") with a fitted wardrobe, a spacious second double (11'6" x 8'2"), and a third bedroom (9'4" x 6'0")—ideal as a nursery, home office, or guest room. A modern family bathroom with full suite completes the upper floor.

Externally, the property includes a private rear garden—a low-maintenance space with patio, ideal for outdoor dining or relaxing. A rare bonus in this area, the home also benefits from two en-bloc garages and allocated parking for up to three vehicles, offering exceptional convenience for families or multi-car households.
