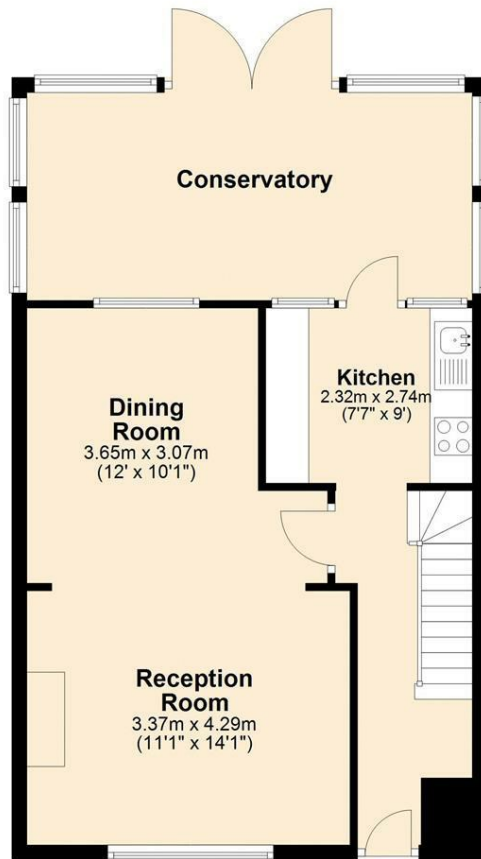






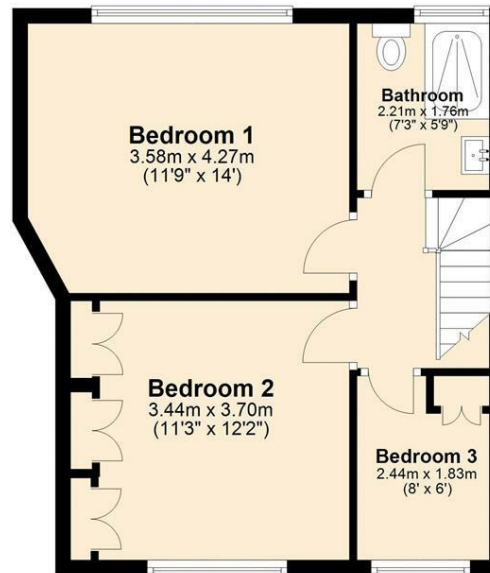
### Ground Floor
