A character terraced house, arranged over three floors and situated in the popular Chequers area of the city centre within a conservation zone. Offered with vacant possession, the accommodation comprises a sitting room, a kitchen/dining room, utility room and cloakroom on the ground floor. On the first floor are two bedrooms and a bathroom together with a further two bedrooms on the top floor. Character features include high ceilings and cast iron fireplaces. Benefits include gas central heating and double glazing. To the rear of the property is a communal pathway leading towards the private cottage garden which has sitting area and lawn together with shrubs and flower beds. The property is within an easy walk of the city centre, Cathedral and main line station.

Wooden front door with glazed panel above, cast iron fireplace with ornamental surround, built in cupboard housing consumer unit.

Stairs to first floor.

Fitted with base and wall units with wood effect worktops, stainless steel sink with mixer tap over, four ring electric hob and electric oven below, space for table and chairs, understairs cupboard, door to:

Work surface with appliance space below, space and plumbing for washing machine, base and wall mounted cupboards and drawers, door to outside.

Wc and hand basin, wall mounted Worcester combination gas boiler for heating and hot water.

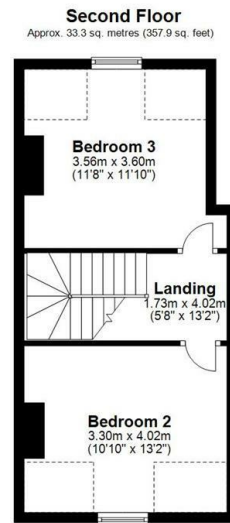
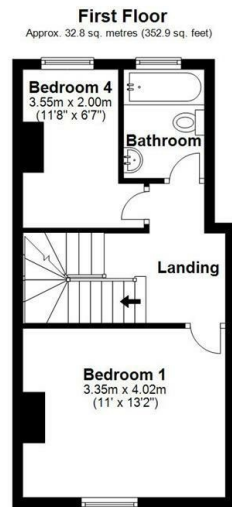
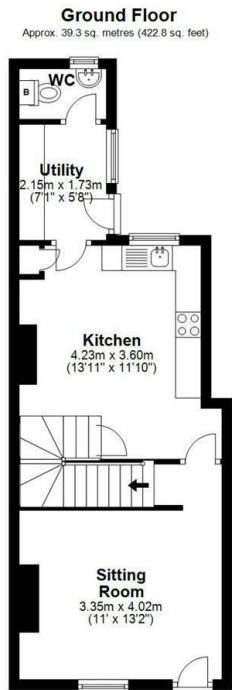
The Council Tax Band is 'C' and the payment for the year 2024/2025 payable to Wiltshire Council is £2245.28

Directions

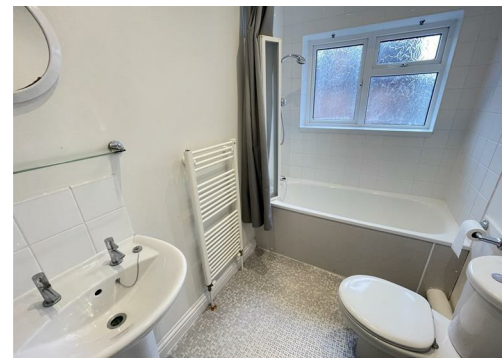
