Upon entering the property is a hallway, leading into a spacious double reception room with solid wood floors, a feature fireplace, built-in shelving and high ceilings. There are large shuttered, floor to ceiling, double glazed windows which offer plenty of natural light. The fitted handmade kitchen is open-plan and alongside the reception. There is an additional separate guest cloakroom.

The staircase has been handcrafted using solid dark mahogany. On the first floor is the master bedroom level which comprises a large bedroom at the rear of the property overlooking the village gardens and surrounding houses. On the second floor are two further bedrooms, both large with built-in storage.

Chelsea Village is located on the boarder of Fulham and Chelsea, also known as the Italian Village. Fulham Road provides great bus routes, the closest store is Waitrose found in Fulham Broadway. Fulham Broadway underground is the nearest station (District line).
