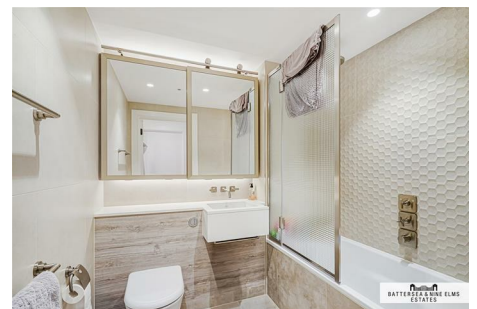




Palmer Road London

The development is ideally located just moments away from Battersea Park, Battersea Power Station and the River Thames.

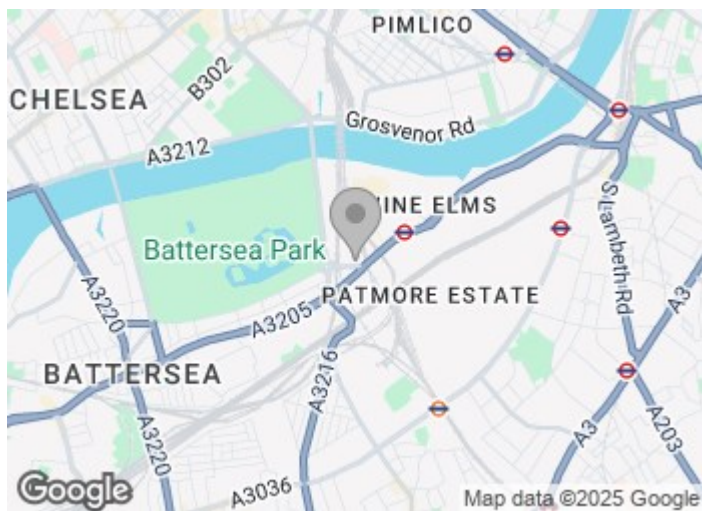
