The property opens a hallway providing access to a light and airy sitting room with attractive bay window and feature fireplace. There is a dining room again with feature fireplace and to the rear of the property the kitchen features integrated Bosch electric hob, oven and accompanying extractor hood. There is also an integrated Bosch dishwasher and a good array of drawers on cupboards providing storage complete the space.

Ascending the stairs to the first floor the main bedroom is to the rear. Bedroom two is also a double and this is accessed via dressing room / nursery. The four piece family bathroom completes the internal accommodation as is comprised of a bath with shower mixer hose attachment, separate shower cubicle, handbasin set within a vanity unit wc and heated towel rail.








Please note that the fireplaces have not been tested.


