A covered storm porch opens into a welcoming sitting room featuring an electric fire with stone-effect surround and a useful understairs storage cupboard.

The space feels warm and comfortable, creating a relaxing area to unwind.

The kitchen / dining room lies to the rear of the property and is fitted with a range of units offering ample storage, along with an integrated oven, hob and extractor hood.

There's plenty of room for a dining table, making this a sociable and practical space for everyday family life. The ground floor is completed by a cloakroom with toilet and handbasin.

Upstairs, the principal bedroom and a spacious single bedroom overlook
the front of the property, while the second double bedroom enjoys garden views to
the rear.All three bedrooms include built-in wardrobes, providing excellent storage.
The family bathroom features a bath with shower screen and mixer hose,
pedestal handbasin and wc.





Living in Sudbury

Sudbury is a thriving market town rich in history and surrounded by the beautiful landscapes of the Stour Valley, which inspired the paintings of Thomas Gainsborough. The town offers an excellent range of amenities including independent shops, cafés, restaurants, a twice-weekly market, and a choice of supermarkets. 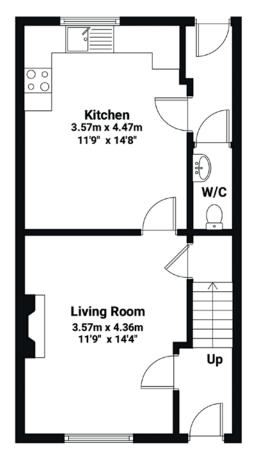


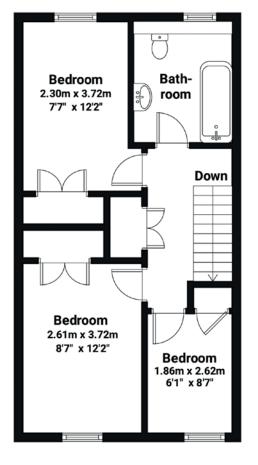

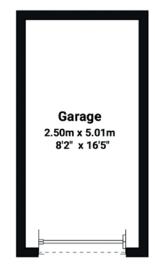
The property occupies a quiet, tucked-away position within a friendly cul-de-sac, ideally placed for easy access to Sudbury's town centre. A gate at the rear opens onto a pathway that connects to the former Sudbury–Long Melford railway line, now part of the scenic St Edmunds Way – ideal for countryside walks, cycling or dog walking.
