Originally part of an old workhouse, the area was redeveloped in 1983 into stunning detached and link-detached homes, many of which, like this one, retain some of the original brickwork. Upon entering, you'll find a convenient downstairs toilet to your left, while the right leads to a recently renovated kitchen, featuring quartz worktops, integrated appliances, and a striking Rangemaster oven as its centerpiece. The kitchen overlooks the quiet road, providing a sense of serenity.

The rear of the property boasts a spacious reception room, enhanced by exposed beams and a cozy log burner, creating a warm, inviting atmosphere. The room flows seamlessly into an extension that serves as the dining area, which is bathed in natural light and offers views of the beautifully landscaped garden. The garden, perfect for nature lovers, has direct access to open fields, making it ideal for dog walking and outdoor activities. The boiler, installed just a year ago, ensures modern efficiency.

Upstairs, there are three generously sized bedrooms. Two are large doubles, and the principal bedroom benefits from an en-suite shower room. The family bathroom services the remaining two bedrooms. Throughout the home, there are charming character features, all fully renovated to a high standard. Completing the property is a garage and driveway, providing ample parking. Located in the picturesque village of Bletchingley, the home is close to traditional pubs, boutique coffee shops, and a range of scenic nature walks.


