



BRETFORTON

Once part of the farmland of Evesham Abbey, Bretforton has a history of market gardening and consists of a huge variety of different properties including a Jacobean Manor House, a Gothic Hall, a Theatre Barn Grange and the stunning St. Leonard's Church, which dates back from the late 13th century. Opposite the Church is the award-winning Fleece Inn, famous for its ciders and real ales where one can enjoy a perfect summer evening in the orchard or a cosy fireside tipple during the colder months. The village is the proud home to Bretforton Silver Band which can trace its' roots back to 1895: a band which plays regularly in the village and surrounding areas. A picturesque village with a wonderful community, Bretforton also has an active and very popular Sports Club as well as a busy Community Social Club. There are several other clubs within the village: drama, books, gardening, crafts to name a few. The successful Community Shop is volunteer led and there is a mobile Post Office and Banking Service in the village three days a week. There is a delightful Pre-School located in the Memorial Hall as well as the Bretforton Village School which can be found in the centre of the village.
