

Surface Water - Flood Risk

This map shows the chance of flooding where rainwater has nowhere to drain. This kind of flooding can occur far from rivers or seas.



Risk Rating: Very low

The map does not contain sufficient information for it to be used to determine flood risk to individual properties, but it does give you an indication of whether your area may be affected by surface water flooding at this risk level.

- **High Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 30 (3.3%) in any one year.
- **Medium Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 100 (1.0%) in any one year.
- **Low Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 1000 (0.25%) in any one year.
- Very Low Risk an area in which the risk is below 1 in 1000 (0.25%) in any one year.



Surface Water - Climate Change

This map shows the future chance of flooding **between 2040 and 2060** where rainwater has nowhere to drain. This kind of flooding can occur far from rivers or seas. The government climate change models cannot predict exactly when the chance of flooding will go up. It could happen at any time during the time period.


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Rivers & Seas - Flood Risk


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- Very Low Risk an area in which the risk is below 1 in 1000 (0.25%) in any one year.

Mine Entry



The Coal Authority has records of over 175,000 mine entries within the UK captured in the National Coal Mining database, derived from sources including abandonment plans, geological and topographical plans.

Coal mining activity is recorded as far back as the 13th century, but prior to 1872 there was no requirement to deposit abandonment plans. It is therefore believed there may be many unrecorded mine entries of which the Authority has no information or knowledge. These entries do not, therefore, appear within the Authority's national dataset as shown on this map.

Conservation Areas



Council Wards


