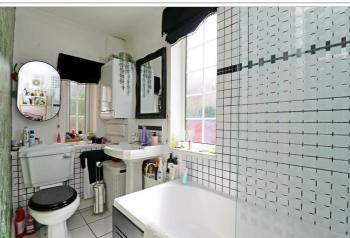

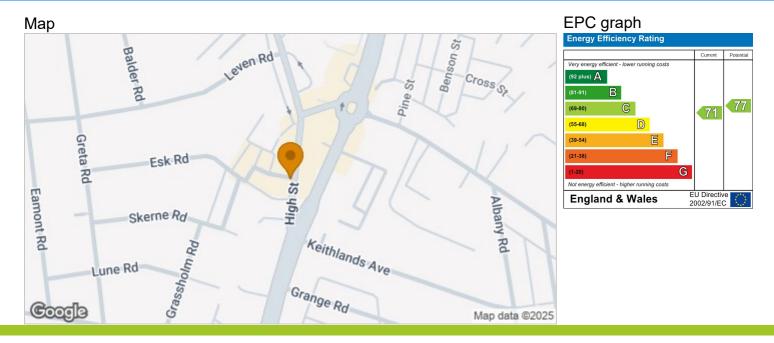




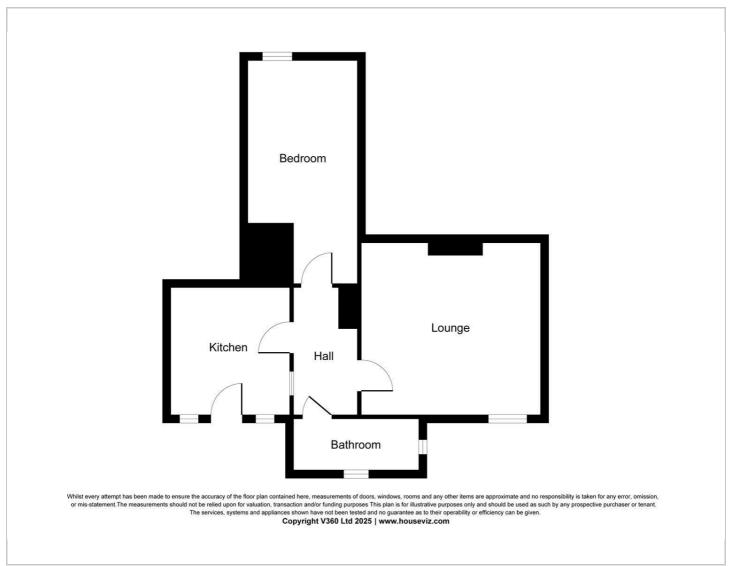








Floor Plan
