BACKGROUND

The history of Templeton on the Green dates back to the end of the 19th Century, when in 1892 William Leiper was commissioned to build a carpet factory. After a rigorous planning process, the Templeton Carpet Factory was permitted, taking inspiration from the Doge's Palace in Venice. Many of the features that were used in the construction of the factory remain today with the turrets, arches and circular windows remaining the focal point for the building.



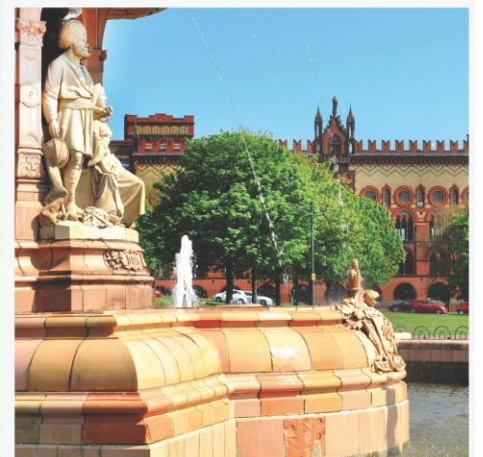
DESCRIPTION

Templeton on the Green is a Business and Lifestyle Village formed around a collection of notable buildings that once formed the Templeton Carpet Factory which closed in 1980. The Village enjoys a prime position overlooking Glasgow Green, alongside the River Clyde at Bridgeton.

The Complex provides a mixture of Offices, Workshops and Studios arranged between Templeton House, The White Studios and Doges.

SETTING

Templeton on the Green sits on the edge of Glasgow Green to the South East of Glasgow City Centre, overlooking the People's Palace and Doulton Fountain. Glasgow Green remains one of Glasgow's most attractive parks which plays host to a range of public events.



AVAILABILITY

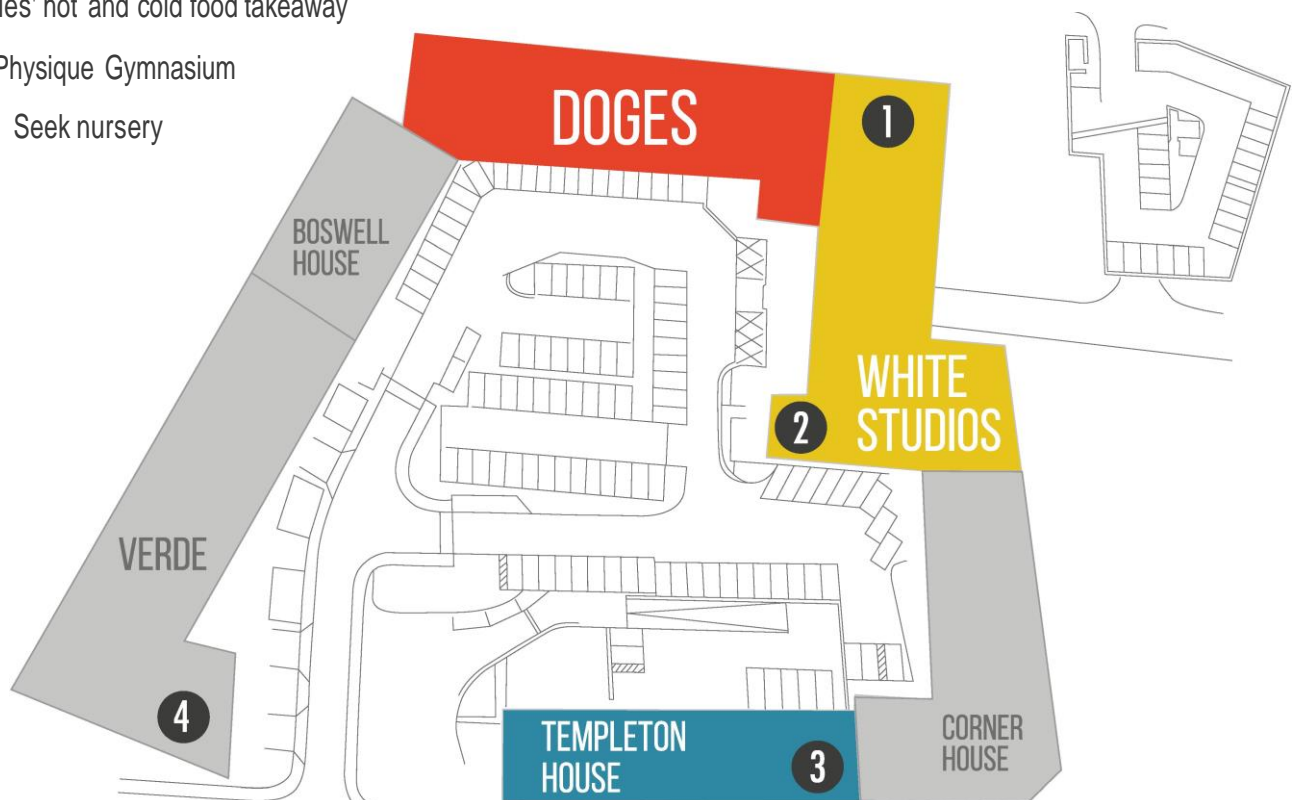
