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1 Introduction to the AMP


The Advanced Manufacturing Park (AMP) is Harworth's flagship development and is home to some of the world's biggest manufacturers including Rolls-Royce, Boeing and McLaren Automotive. It is anchored by the world-renowned University of Sheffield Advanced Manufacturing Research Centre (AMRC).

The AMP is a world renowned centre of excellence in the advanced manufacturing sector and is the culmination of over 20 years of work to bring together world class R&D businesses and supply chain manufacturers to develop cutting-edge technologies and advanced manufacturing processes.

There are now over 1,750 people employed at the AMP with around 4,000 expected once the site is fully developed out.

Harworth's primary role is to be the custodian of the AMP vision and work together with the AMRC and other occupiers to grow and support the UK advanced manufacturing sector. As master developer, we provide key infrastructure across the site and provide a range of property solutions to facilitate expansion of existing businesses and attract new occupiers as part of their growth and development programmes.





The AMP is located within the heart of the Sheffield City Region and northern manufacturing heartland. Located on the Rotherham/Sheffield border, it is just 2 miles from junction 33 of the M1 with over 2 million people living within a 30 minute drive time and over 21,000 graduates per year from Sheffield's two leading universities.

The AMP sits in the heart of England and is only 2 miles from the M1. It is just 5 miles fro he centres of Sheffield and Rotherham and close to the Peak District National Park.

It also has excellent connections to a wide variety of destinations across the UK.

3 Current Occupiers

The AMP is anchored by the Advanced Manufacturing Research Centre (AMRC) which is a network of world-leading research and innovation centres working with advanced manufacturing companies around the globe. They transform industrial and economic performance by working with manufacturers, making step changes in productivity, increasing competitiveness, developing new products and processes and training new talent and skills.

The AMRC has helped to attract a range of manufacturing companies to the AMP such as Rolls-Royce and McLaren Automotive together with their supply chains.

1.5m sq. ft has been developed for advanced manufacturers at the AMP within the last fifteen years, establishing the site as one of the UK's key centres of manufacturing and high value employment. Current occupiers specialise in a number of advanced technologies including: materials joining, high-performance maching, composites technology, high-integrity castings, engineering design, rapid prototyping, additive manufacture, and testing and certification. Technology sectors currently include: aerospace, automotive, medical, sport, environmental, energy, oil, gas, nuclear power generation and construction.

5 The Waverley Story

In addition to the development of the AMP, Harworth are also delivering the rest of the wider Waverley site. Together with the AMP, the site totals 740 acres and will deliver over 2m sq ft of commercial space, a local retail heart, up to 3,900 new homes, a new primary school and 300 acres of green spaces and lakes.

The new retail heart will provide new facilities for the area including bars, restaurants and shops plus a medical centre and community space.

There are already over 1,250 homes occupied providing a range of house types to cater for local people and employees on the AMP.

The green spaces include two large lakes and an extensive network of cycle lanes and trails to promote wellbeing and sustainability.

Harworth is also working with adjoining landowners, Rotherham Council, Sheffield City Region LEP and SYPTE to promote and design a new railway station on the edge of the AMP, utilising the existing Sheffield to Lincoln line to support worker and resident movements away from the car.
