A rarely available and architecturally designed one bedroom top floor apartment within this prominent Grade II listed house on one of the West Ends rare and most sought after garden squares.

Situated on one of the few green open spaces in the Soho Conservation area, prominently stands No 15 Soho Square. This Grade II listed house is one of only two surviving original houses to the square and dates back to circa 1677.

Previously home to an eclectic mix of inhabitants including Lords, Earls and Countesses the house has now been painstakingly converted into four unique and luxurious apartments, consisting of two, one bedroom units, a two bedroom and a two/three bedroom duplex.

Each apartment has been meticulously and sympathetically designed to compliment the buildings rich past and seamlessly blends the many period features with today's latest contemporary materials and fixtures and fittings.

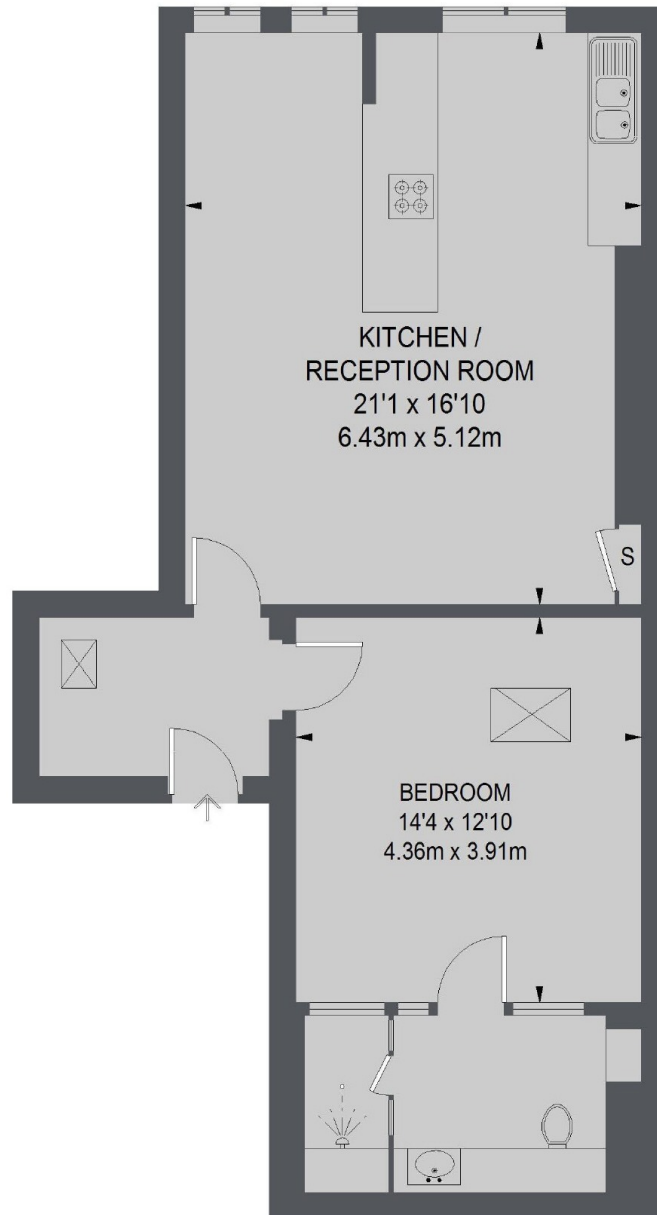
