Corner plot gardens with lawn, off road parking on a hard standing driveway to side & a clothes drying area to rear. Hall

There is a communal entrance hall for the two flats with a UPVC double glazed entrance door and coir flooring.

There is a fire door leading into the hallway of the ground floor apartment, fitted carpet, small cupboard.

Lounge

Large living room with dual aspect from two large UPVC double glazed windows, one being a bay window to the side and the other facing the front, fitted carpet, two electric heaters, cupboard housing hot water cylinder.

Kitchen

UPVC double glazed window to side, tiled floor, a range of modern base, drawer and eye level units, work surfaces, stainless steel sink unit with mixer taps, built-in electric oven & hob, space for usual appliances.

Double Bedroom

UPVC double glazed windows to front & side (one being a bay window) fitted carpet, electric heater.

Shower Room

UPVC double glazed opaque window, tiled floor, electric heater, shower cubicle, wash hand basin, wc.

There is a garden to front and a driveway & clothes drying area to side.

Glenfield

Glenfield is a popular large village 5 miles to the West of Leicester city centre with a population of approx 9,500. There are two well regarded primary schools,

three pubs, St Peters church and a range of local shopping facilities including a relatively new Morrison's store on Station Road. There is nearby open countryside including Bradgate Park and Gynsills conservation area. There is easy access to M1, A46 & A50 main routes. Glenfield General Hospital & Leics County Council are two large employers. Glenfield is mentioned in the Domesday book of 1086 and is also famous for its now defunct railway tunnel built by Stevenson and once the longest in the world. Regular bus services into Leicester serve the village and Leicester train station is approx 5 miles away.

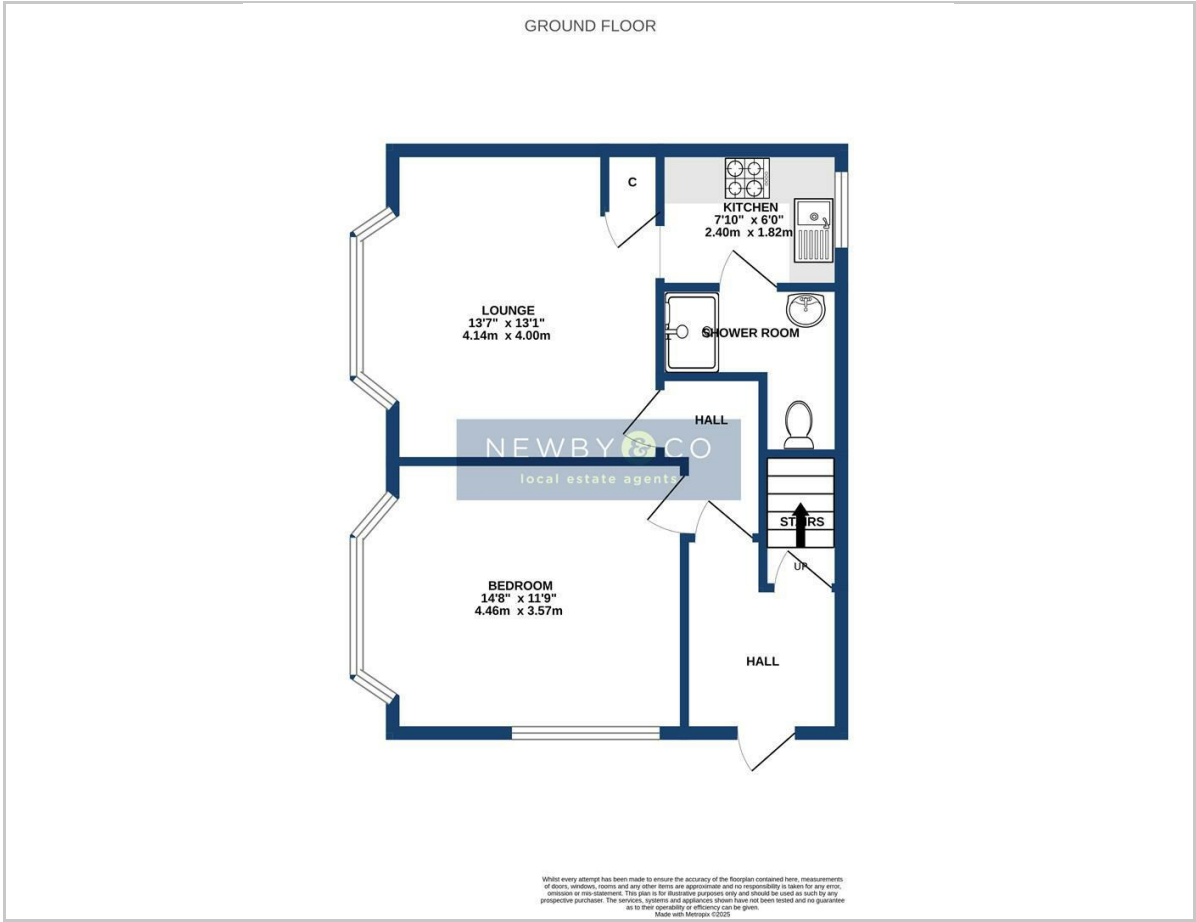
It has a Council Tax Band of A which means a charge of £1,582.11 for tax year ending March 2026
