

## 59b Liberty Road

A 1 bedroom self-contained first floor apartment situated within a traditional detached property on a good corner plot in popular residential area. The area benefits from good schools, shops, recreational amenities, bus routes and major road links. This apartment (there are only two) has electric heating, UPVC double glazing, lounge, a fitted kitchen, double bedroom & bathroom. Corner plot gardens with lawn, off road parking on a hard standing driveway to side & a clothes drying area to rear. #### Hall

There is a communal entrance hall for the two flats with a UPVC double glazed entrance door and coir flooring.

There is a firedoor leading to a staircase up to the landing which has UPVC double glazed window to side, fitted carpet, doors leading to all rooms.

### Lounge

UPVC double glazed windows to front & side, fitted carpet, electric heater.

UPVC double glazed window to side, fitted carpet, electric heater.

#### **Bathroom**

UPVC double glazed opaque windows to rear & side, tiled floor, heated towel rail, a modern white suite comprising of panelled bath, pedestal wash hand basin, wc, extractor fan, airing cupboard housing hot water cylinder, access to loft.

#### Outside

There is a garden to front and a driveway & clothes drying area to side.

### Glenfield

Glenfield is a popular large village 5 miles to the West of Leicester city centre with a population of approx 9,500. There are two well regarded primary schools, three pubs, St Peters church and a range of local shopping facilities including a relatively new Morrison's store on Station Road. There is nearby open countryside including Bradgate Park and Gynsills conservation area. There is

easy access to M1, A46 & A50 main routes. Glenfield General Hospital & Leics County Council are two large employers. Glenfield is mentioned in the Domesday book of 1086 and is also famous for its now defunct railway tunnel built by Stevenson and once the longest in the world. Regular bus services into Leicester serve the village and Leicester train station is approx 5 miles away.










### Floor Plan


