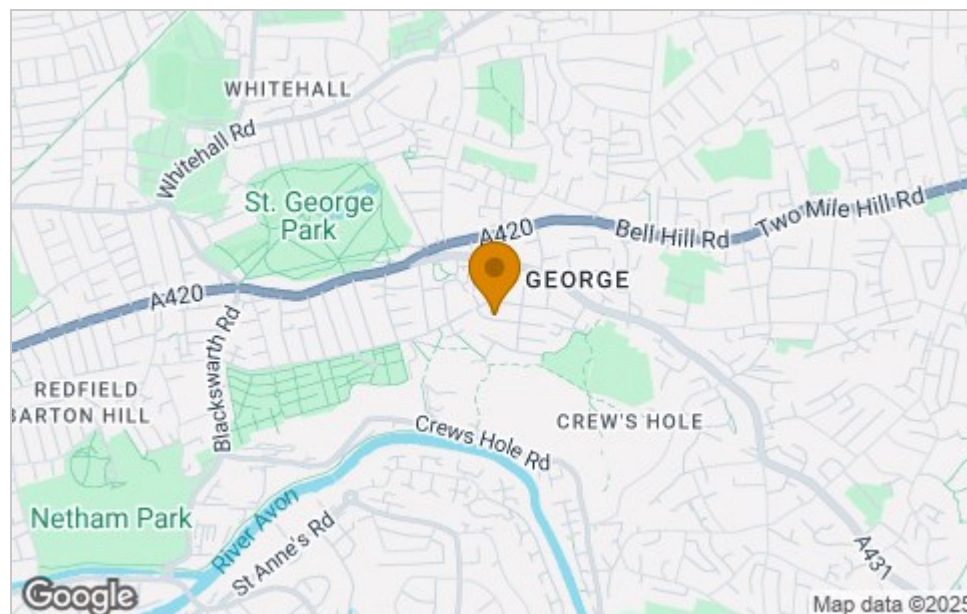




Floor Plan
