With Easton's vibrant community on your doorstep and a short stroll from the Bristol to Bath cycle path and St Marks Road with its other popular local eateries and shops.

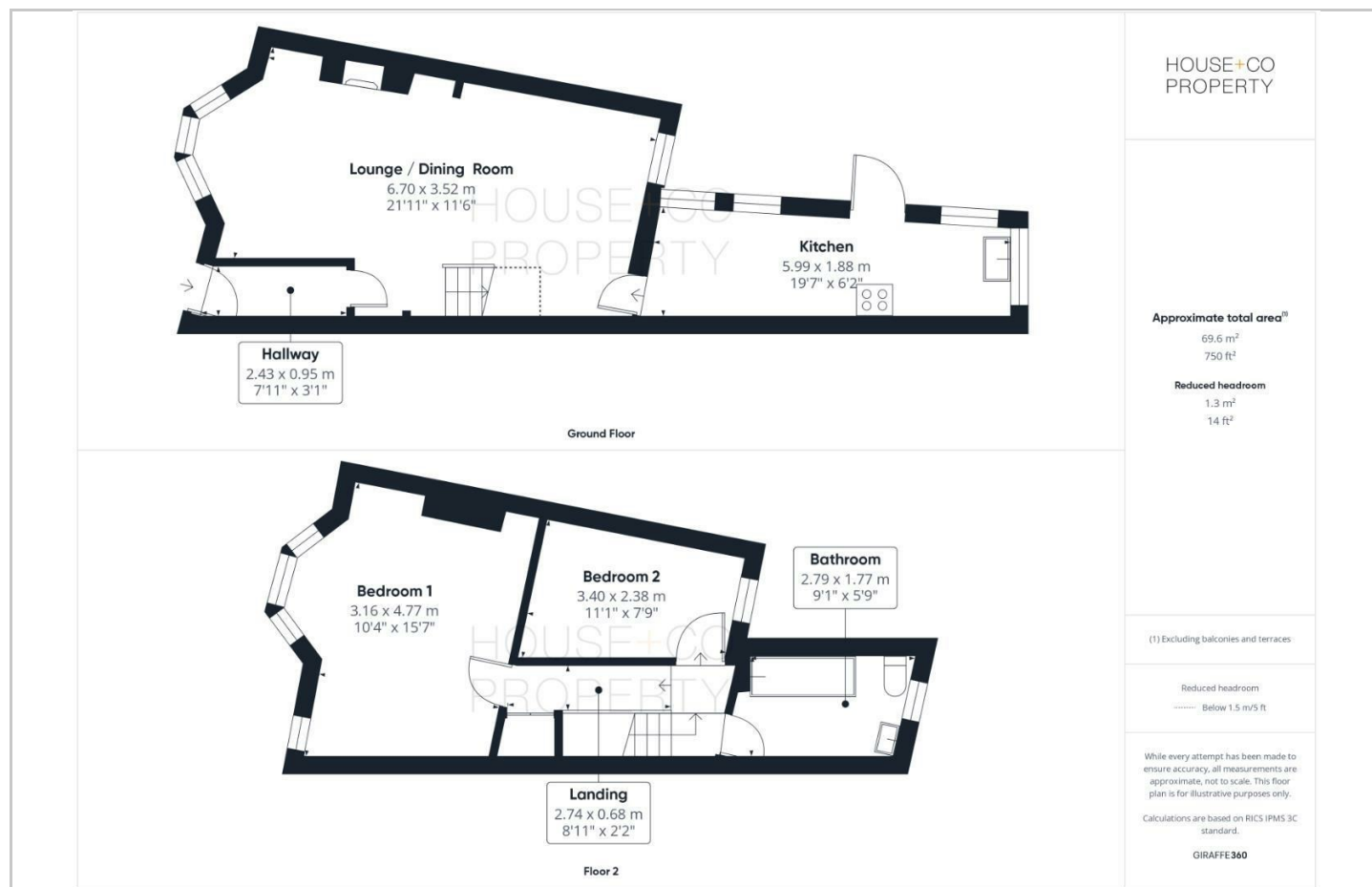

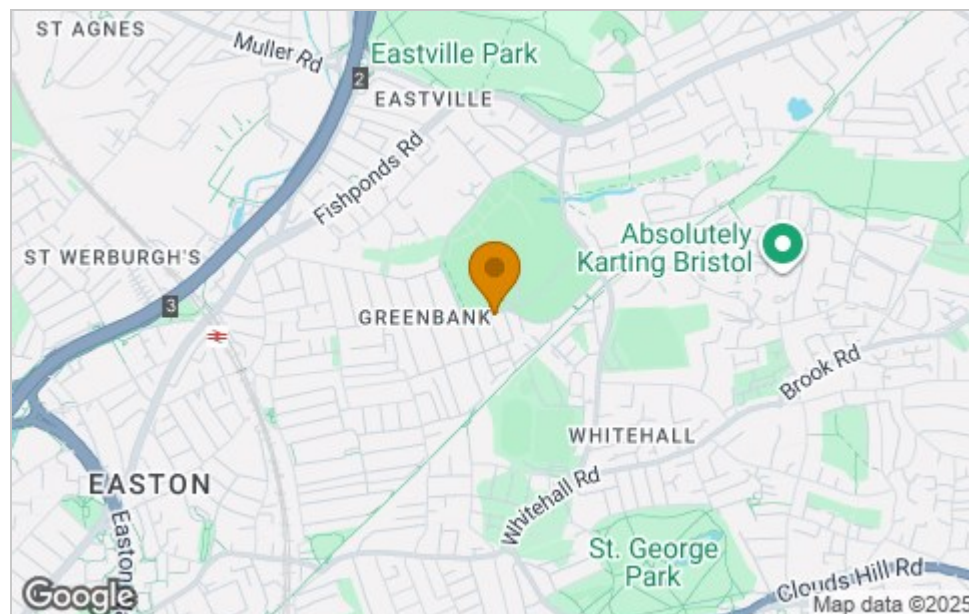




Floor Plan



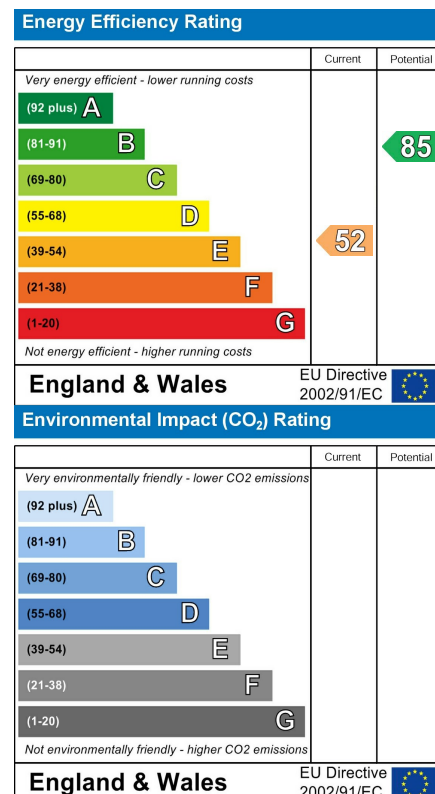
Area Map
