PROPERTY



The property is set in the most idyllic setting on the edge of the village of Ponsanooth and located in a very advantageous position between Truro and Falmouth and allowing easy access to St. Agnes and Godrevy on the North Coast.

The grounds are simply stunning and it is the setting and privacy that make this residence so special. This is a fundamental part of why the letting elements of the property have been so successful and the 3 wonderful holiday lets have achieved their '5 Star, Gold Award' status. The expansive gardens and grounds are just magical and make the perfect backdrop for special days, hence Cosawes Barton's popularity as a wedding venue.

The main residence is a very charming and elegant property that faces into the grounds and away from the cottages, providing it with a great deal of privacy. Entering into the house there is a wonderful feeling of calm with the broad entrance hallway drawing you in. The generous sitting room and dining room are set on either side of the hall and offer very comfortable accommodation with their respective open fire and wood burning stove. Just beyond is the kitchen with its central island and to one side is a wonderful breakfast room, which is vaulted to the ceiling and features a large mezzanine that makes the perfect space for a study area. The staircase leads from the hallway to a wide landing area. The master suite is just gorgeous with views to the grounds and there are 3 further lovely bedrooms to enjoy with a very stylish bathroom to support them.





LOCATION

The property is conveniently located on the edge of the village of Ponsanooth, which offers a range of local services including a shop, a pub and a school. Just a short drive away, access is provided to Restronguet Creek at Devoran which is popular with all manner of water sports enthusiasts, for sailing, kayaking and paddle boarding. The picture perfect Pandora Inn at Mylor is also a highly favoured stop off point for people on a fine summers evening. Mylor Harbour offers excellent boating facilities and access to the renowned sailing waters of the Carrick Roads, enabling trips across the wonderful Falmouth Bay to St Mawes, or access to the Helford River. Falmouth is four miles away and offers a fantastic range of interesting shops, restaurants and bars as well as wonderful sandy beaches and further boating opportunities. Truro offers county leading schooling with both private and state options available.
