








The property has great charm and the entrance hallway makes a wonderful first impression with its impressive staircase and tiled flooring. The sitting room is bright and airy, running the full depth of the house with views to the front and rear gardens. There is also access to the conservatory, which is a lovely space to relax in. The living room is another fine room, featuring a beautiful fireplace and bay window. To the rear is the stunning kitchen, with a high vaulted ceiling and an Aga. The dining room is set to one side and finished with the same lovely oak flooring as the kitchen. Upstairs, the master bedroom is very well thought out, and on this level, there are two further bedrooms along with a family bathroom. The upper floor offers two additional bedrooms, one currently used as an office, and another bathroom.

Outside, the garden to the front features a raised terrace and a private dining area to the side of the conservatory. The majority of the garden is to the rear, which is very private, with a driveway providing access to the garage.






