


SANDBANKS

Sandbanks is recognised as being home to one of the UK's – if not the world's - finest beaches. In fact, no other beach in the country has held the coveted Blue Flag award continuously and for longer, 35 years and counting.

LYMINGTON

A historic town nestled between the New Forest and the Solent, this ancient sea port is today a mecca for sailing with three marinas and a whole host of other cultural and retailing reasons to visit.





CHRISTCHURCH

Believed to be England's first port, historic Christchurch sits where the Stour and Avon rivers flow into the harbour and then the sea. The impressive Priory, Hengistbury Head and Mudeford Quay are well worth exploring.

NEW FOREST

The New Forest National Park was actually founded by William the Conqueror as a hunting ground almost a millennia ago in 1079. It's free to access, open all year round, has many ancient towns and villages to explore and is famed for the free wandering horses, donkeys and ponies that live there.



PURBECKS

The Purbecks host some of the UK's most recognisable landmarks and popular visitor destinations. It's also a gateway to nature and history; an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and the start of the 95 mile long Jurassic Coast, England's first natural UNESCO World Heritage site.
