

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Description:

This length of the Cubley Brook lies close to the village of Boylestone. It is accessible from various points along the brook, namely the footbridge at Boylestone and Marjory Lane.

The brook contains chub, brown trout (up to 2lbs) present in many pools and some graying, roach and dace. The upper access point and start of the fishing is the footbridge at Boylestone. What3words://positives.square.galleries.

The first 200+ yards are double bank.

The lower access point is from Margery Lane. What3words://crouching.frown.Monday.

There is about 200+ yards of double bank fishing downstream from here, ending at a big tree on the east bank.

Access is over the sturdy fence and you have to wade the shallow ford to get to the east bank. Parking is on the verge at both access points, the lower point has a wide verge so you can completely clear the road.

The rights comprise as shown on the attached plan.

Point A to Point B Fishing on both banks

Point B to Point C Fishing on eastern bank

Point C to Point D Access only along eastern bank

Point D to Point Y Fishing on eastern bank Point Y to Point Z Fishing on both banks Point X to Point Y Access
