The main homestead provides a four bedroom bungalow along an airfield currently used for light aircraft together with an aircraft hangar, a fully equipped commercial café and adjoining shop with ample parking.

The property is being offered as a whole and whilst it may appeal to those wishing to continue its use as an active airfield there could be a great many other alternative uses subject to planning consents

It occupies in an excellent location south of Ashbourne fronting the A515 at Darley Moor.

Long Chimneys Farm is a single storey detached house which sitting in its own gardens with ample parking. Adjoining this is a large agricultural building, a number of stables and a static caravan all set within 13 acres, some of which may have long term planning opportunities.

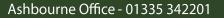
The buildings access way and parking are on freehold land, whilst the grass runway is on leasehold land held under a 1954 Act Tenancy

A large agricultural building adjoins the site and a number of stables and a static caravan all set within 13 acres.











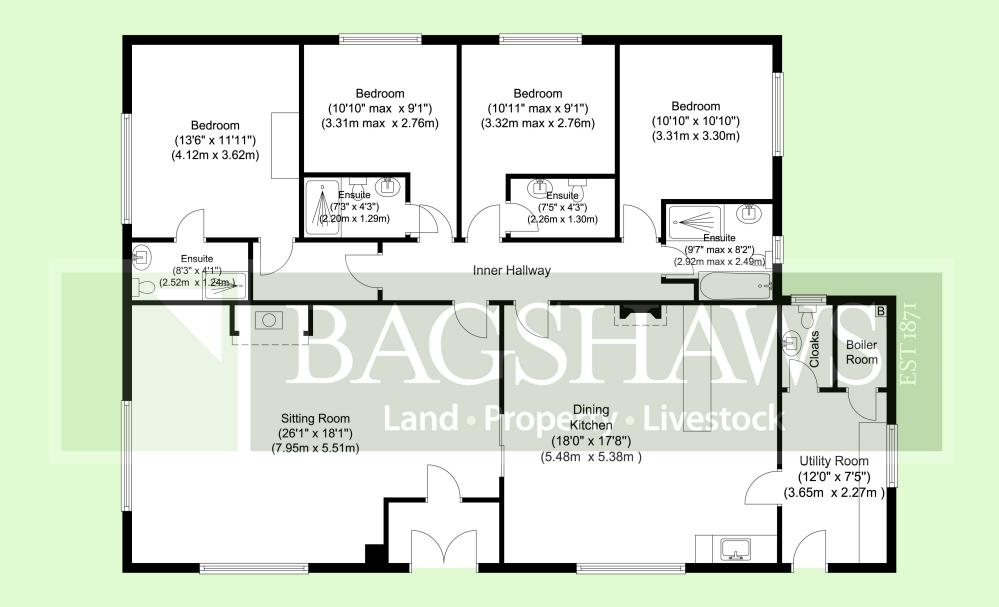

Assessments First



Long Chimneys Buildings and Land

Approximately 13 acres of level grassland fronting the A515 and includes some areas of concrete being part of the discussed World War II Airfield which may have some potential for development subject to planning.

There is excellent access off the concrete road leading to the airfield.

There is a large agricultural building, 12 stables and ancillary buildings.

The field parcels are well situated and are suitably sized for either livestock or arable farming.

Currently all the farm is laid to pasture and used for grazing or mowing. There are areas of hardstanding which may have alternative uses.

There are two small paddocks near the farmhouse, which together with its immediate garden form an attractive focal point for the farm. There is an excellent access into the farm yard and house with a large turning area both in front of and along side the main buildings.







Airfield Buildings and Cafe

The Aircraft Hangar is a high quality and expansive building currently used for storing aeroplanes but may have potential for other uses and is understood to have been built to commercial specifications. Please note the mezzanine office is not included

Next to the hangar is a Café with an excellent commercial kitchen, seating area for approximately 50 covers and within the building is an area used as a shop selling equipment related to the flying club. These buildings are approached by a long stretch of former concrete runway which is included within the freehold title.

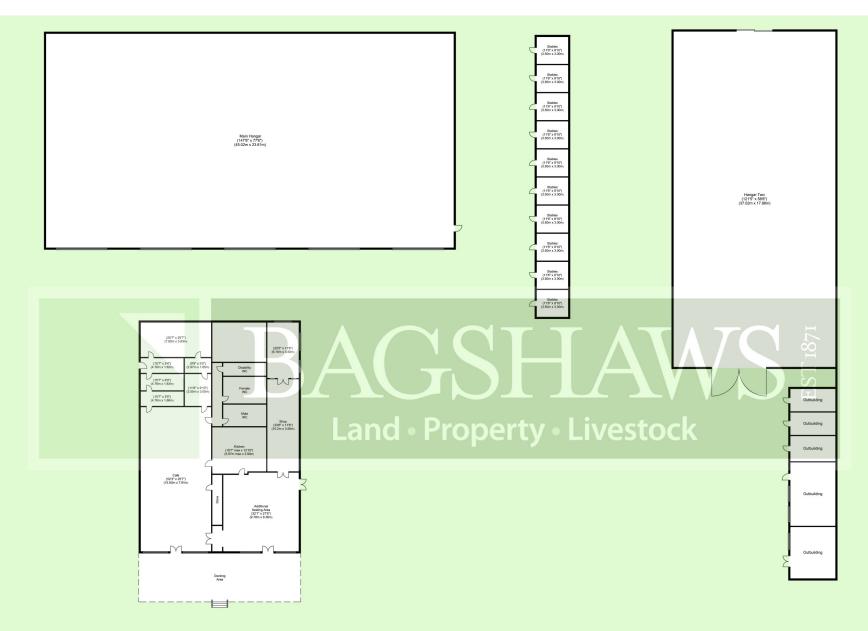
The runway itself is on land held under 1954 Act Lease and extends to approximately 35 acres. It is all laid to grass and the runway itself has an all weather terrain to permit land of light aircraft throughout the year
