DESCRIPTION

The property comprises a triangular plot of land that has previously been used as a concrete mixing site. The property is situated over two main plateau's which are predominantly concrete hard standing. There are two points of access from Hall Lane into the site servicing each of these areas. Within the centre of the site, there is a concrete mixing facility which will remain in situ.

The site is fully secure and enclosed by perimeter fencing.

LOCATION

The property is located on Hall Lane in Bradford, approximately 1.2 miles to the south of Bradford city centre. The property is accessed via Hall Lane which in turn provides access to Wakefield Road and is within the periphery of Bradford city centre. The M606 can be accessed within 1.3 miles to the south west, which in turn provides connectivity to the M62.
