DESCRIPTION

The building comprises a modern two storey office building built approximately 20 years ago. It is of steel framed construction with part-brick and part-curtain wall facing elevations. It has a monopitch roof with a metal clad covering. The building has powder coated aluminium double glazed windows. Internally, the property is air conditioned, with raised floors throughout. There are two 5 person/400kg passenger lifts installed. There are 22 car parking spaces.


The property is assessed as having a rateable value of £62,500 in the 2023 Rating List.
