Externally the property has a garden to the front which is laid to shingle and there is a pathway across the front of the terrace. At the rear there is a shared vehicular access leading to the rear garden which could be adapted to create easy parking with a low maintenance garden beyond.

Elm View is a really convenient location being just a few minutes walk from the town centre and local schools. Bath city centre is eleven miles and Bristol city centre is fifteen miles making this property an ideal commuter base.


