There is a light and airy L shaped and open plan lounge, dining room, kitchen, the lounge area has a large picture window to front overlooking garden and open fireplace (not tested). The kitchen provides a good range of units and overlooks the rear garden with door also to side drive / car port. From the dining area are patio doors leading into a conservatory with doors onto garden. On the first floor are three decent sized bedrooms and a family bathroom.

The property currently has oil fired central heating; we are advised mains gas is available in the road to the front of the house. Double glazing throughout.

Outside to front is a smart level garden enclosed with a low-lying wall. There is a private side drive leading to a car port and garage (with power and light). To the rear is a fully enclosed garden with a private southerly aspect.

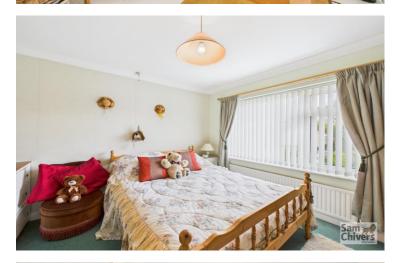










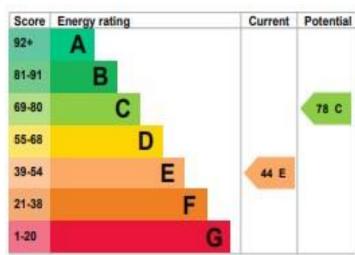
