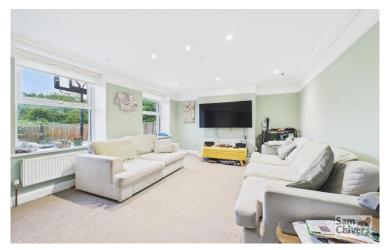
'A spacious three bedroom terraced house with good size bedrooms, two bathrooms and private parking for at least two vehicles!'

This three bedroom mid terrace home is set in a quiet position within Westfield and offers really generous sized living accommodation with the added bonus of being sold without an onward chain. The property requires some finishing works and has double glazing and gas central heating.
