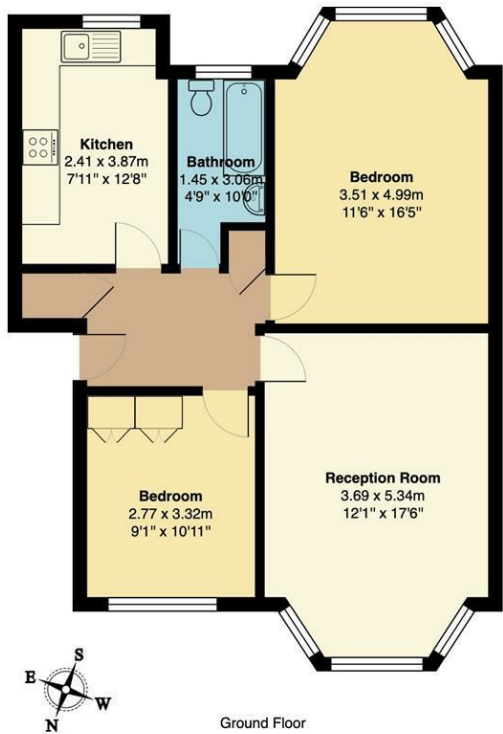

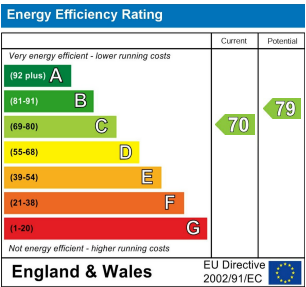

To the rear, beautifully tended communal gardens unfold—a peaceful retreat of sweeping lawns, mature trees, and vibrant flowerbeds, all framed by a wisteria-draped pergola leading into this tranquil oasis.

Inside, a warm and airy hallway forms the heart of the home, its crisp white walls and wooden flooring creating a calm, neutral backdrop. For effortless connectivity, you're well placed between two key stations.
