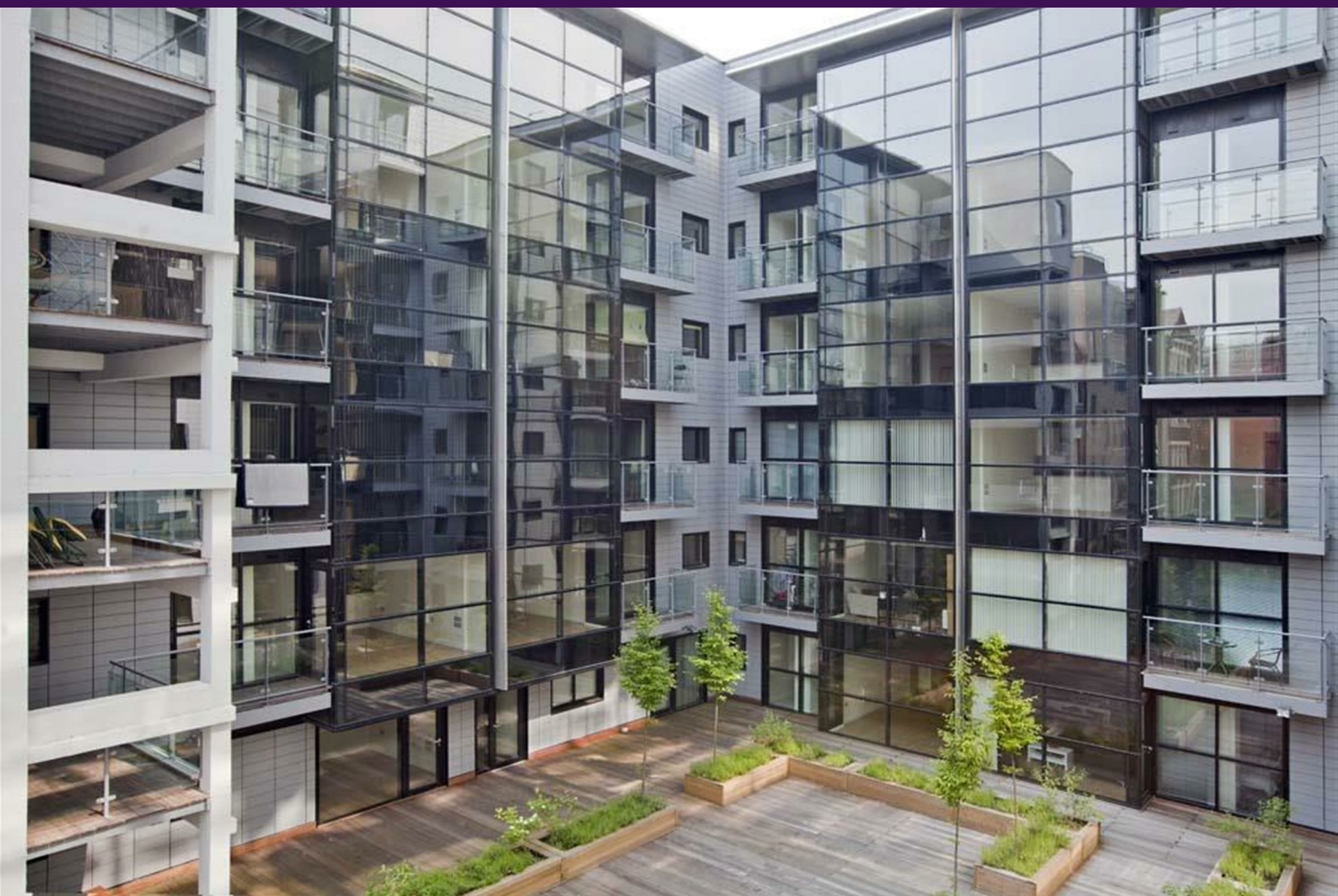




Hamilton House, Pall Mall, Liverpool

This two bedroom apartment is smack bang in the heart of Liverpool's bustling city centre, perfectly placed for university students and those living/working in and around Liverpool.

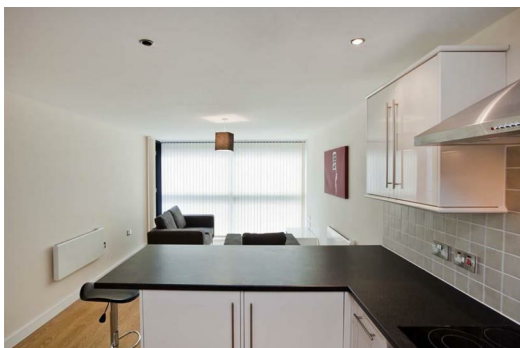

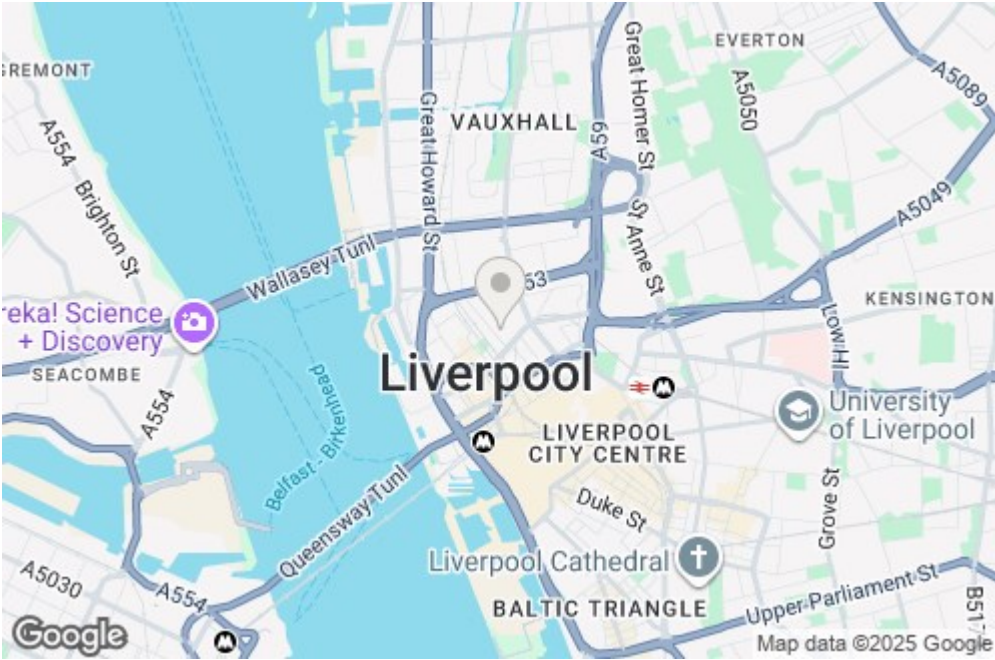
