Whippingham Road is a quiet residential road, primarily consisting of young families, located within the Elm Grove district of Brighton close to all the city has to offer.

Regular bus services can be found on Elm Grove leading both in and out of Brighton whilst Brighton mainline station is just over a mile away. For those that drive, the A270 leads directly on to the A27.












WHIPPINGHAM ROAD
