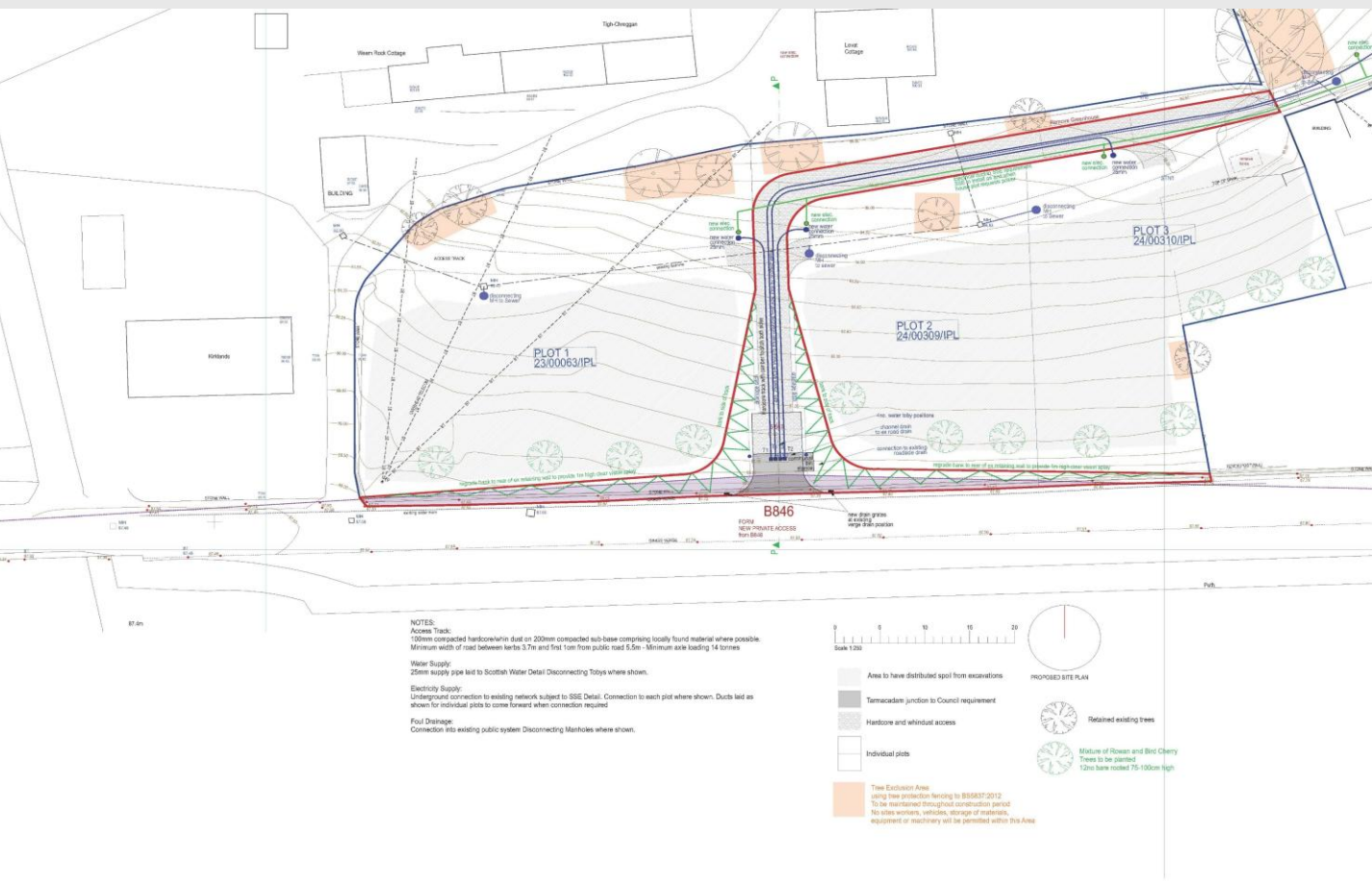
DIRECTIONS
