#### Risk Rating: Very low






### Flood Risk Surface Water - Climate Change








### Flood Risk Rivers & Seas - Flood Risk

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



The Coal Authority has records of over 175,000 mine entries within the UK captured in the National Coal Mining database, derived from sources including abandonment plans, geological and topographical plans.



It is therefore believed there may be many unrecorded mine entries of which the Authority has no information or knowledge. These entries do not, therefore, appear within the Authority's national dataset as shown on this map.


